•	In the light of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ and the upcoming
	celebration of Resurrection Sunday celebrated on April 1st this year, I want to stir your
	hearts and minds that God wants to do a THING in all of us.
•	He wants to take us to a in Him that we've never been before. I realm and
	reality of Victory, Triumph and Blessings in Christ.
•	As Joshua led Israel into the Promised Land, he told the people to get ready to go where
	they had never gone before.
•	And after 40 years them wandering in the wilderness, and our being in the hotel for 4
	months, it is time to prepare for NEW, BIGGER and GREATER things from God!
•	IT IS TIME TO GOD'S PLAN! PREPARTION TIME IS SO IMPORTANT!
•	We must understand that is instant, but is
	a present <i>position</i> and, also an on-going <i>process</i> as well as future <i>promise</i> .
•	GOD IS DOING A THING IN YOU AND ME. YOUR OPPORTUNITY IS NOW!
•	SANCTIFY = to make holy, to purify, to cleanse, to set apart, and to consecrate.
	 It means to set apart something or someone for a special purpose.
	 SANCTIFICATION means not only separation from <u>sin</u> but also separation from
	what may be <i>permissible</i> . It is an of God.
•	P.C. Nelson, a Bible scholar, said this about <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> : "Sanctification is
	realized in the believer by recognizing his identification with Christ in His death, burial and
	resurrection, and by faith reckoning daily upon the fact of union with Christ, and by
	offering daily every faculty continually to the dominion of the Holy Spirit."

- In other words, _____ begins with the work God did for us in the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ.
 - Jesus identified with us. IDENTIFICATION means to treat or consider as one and the same.
 - Identification with Christ can be compared to the difference between a photo and an x-ray. IN CHRIST, you just see things differently.
 - The GOSPELS are the photograph; what man saw.
 - The EPISTLES are the x-ray; what God saw.

OUR IDENTIFICATION WITH CHRIST

<u>Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)</u> – "I have been <u>crucified with Christ</u>; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

- (Laubach) "Christ took me to the cross with Him and I died there with Him."
- (Distilled Bible) "I consider myself as having died and now enjoying a second existence, which is simply Jesus using my body."
- <u>2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)</u> "Therefore, if anyone is <u>in Christ</u>, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."
- Romans 6:4 says that we were "...buried with Christ..."
- Romans 6:11 says "...to reckon ourselves dead to sin..."

- o One translation says, "you are dead to sin... motionless as a corpse."
- The word RECKON is an accountant term; meaning that in light of the reality and truth that Jesus did it all for us and He was our SUBSTITUTE and our SACRIFICE; we don't try to figure up the facts but to accurately record the facts.
- What a picture! But we did not stay dead. Romans 6:4 continues, "...We have been justified and raised with Him by the glory of God."
- And according to <u>Romans 6:14</u>, sin shall not have dominion over us <u>in Christ</u>.
 <u>Romans 6:4</u> in its entirety says: "Therefore we are <u>buried with Him</u> by baptism into
- death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life." If you want to experience your _____ identity in Christ, you cannot keep looking in the past. YOU ARE DEAD TO ALL THAT! But the devil knows that if he can challenge and steal your identity, he will hinder _____. John 10:10 (NKJV) - "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly." The Enemy Wants to Steal Two Things From You: #1 - Your Identity: There's two identities the enemy wants to steal from us: (1) _____ IDENTITY (Who you are IN CHRIST) and our (2) **IDENTITY** (Who you are in the BODY OF CHRIST). #2 - Your Future: Thieves do not rob empty houses! They come because you have something. Don't let the devil steal your future! Not doing what you're supposed to be doing ____ and IN time opens the door for the enemy to steal your future! WHEN MY LIFE COUNTS FOR IN THIS LIFE, THEN MY LIFE COUNTS FOR _____ IN THE NEXT LIFE! Our focus is to be on others, not myself "Well done thou good and a faithful servant..." - Matthew 25:21, 23 **Good** = is benefiting and being a blessing to others. I can't build my eternity when I get into eternity; I build my life now! NOW IS THE TIME TO SANCCTIFY YOURSELF AND ESTABLISH YOUR IDENTITY IN CHRIST. Too many Christian believers are victims of stolen ____ THEFT! Many people live and die and never really find their true identity. **TOO OFTEN** PEOPLE NEVER FIGURE OUT WHO THEY ARE, SO THEY ACT LIKE SOMEONE ELSE AND WHO THEY ARE NOT. We must understand, that when we become believers in Christ, we can longer identify with just our natural family, we are now identified with Christ.
