SOME DISCIPLESHIP BASICS: (Matthew 28:18 -20)

- #1) There is a _____ and a _____ to discipleship.
- #2) You have to _____ a disciple before you can _____ a disciple-maker.
- #3) A Christian Disciple is a *disciplined learner* (in diligence, devotion and dedication) and a *disciplined follower* (in belief and behavior) of the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus is Lord in and over their lives and they have surrendered to the Lordship of Jesus in all aspects of their lives.
- #4) To *receive* Jesus is free, but to *follow* Jesus will cost you something!
- #5) Three Basic Aspects of Discipleship:
 - **GO** – Evangelism; Doing the Work of an Evangelist;
 - **BAPTIZE** – Identification; Outward Sign of an Inward Grace (Water Baptism – outward sign, Baptism into the Body of Christ – inward grace); Circumcision of the heart (spirit) [In covenant with the Lord - - sign of the covenant is baptism; seal of the covenant is the presence of the Holy Spirit the agent of the New Birth].
 - The Doctrine of Baptisms reveal God’s Purpose, Plan and Power of Identification; Law of Identification – (**Galatians 2:20; Romans 6:4**)
 - Who you are in Christ (individual identity)
 - Who you are in the Body of Christ (corporate identity)
 - (1) *The New Birth* (Baptism into the Body Christ) (2) *Water Baptism* (Identification with Christ); (3) *The Infilling of the Holy Spirit* (Baptism in the Holy Spirit)
 - **TEACH** – (1) The *Doctrine*, (2) The *Disciplines* and (3) The *Deeds* of Christ.
 - The Gospels – The Basic Teachings of Jesus
 - The Epistles – The Advanced Teachings of Jesus (the words He left the earth unuttered).
 - Teach by *principle* (precept) and *practice* (example) – *Model; Mentor; Manage and Motivate* like Jesus.
 - *Teaching* – How to **walk** like Christ: (Love, Faith, Prayer, Righteousness, Holy Spirit, etc.)
 - *Teaching* – Doing the **works** of Christ: (Preach, Teach, Heal, Help, Kingdom Ministry and Missions, etc.)
- #6) What Jesus looked for in a Disciple? (Read Luke 5:1 – 11)
 - **Jesus’ model of ministry shows us that we can *teach* the masses, but we can *disciple* only a few.**
