Read Isaiah 53:3-5 and 1 Peter 1:18-19

- We have been redeemed **by** the Blood of Jesus Christ our Lord and redeemed **from** (1) the hand of the _____ (**Psalms 107:2; Psalms 106:10**), **from** (2) the curse of the _____ (**Galatians 3:13**) and **from** (3) every _____ deed (**Titus 2:14**).
- Jesus' blood was shed for our SINS and He sacrificed Himself for us on the cross. Jesus' shed blood was necessary for our _____.

SEVEN (7) PLACES JESUS SHED HIS BLOOD:

- The number seven means completion. On the cross when Jesus said "**it is finished**" at that moment He atoned (**atoned** = to supply satisfaction for; to make amends; reconcile) for our _____, transgressions, iniquities, sicknesses, diseases, peace and salvation.
- (1st Place) = In the _____ of Gethsemane for restore our _____ Power; (2nd Place) = When He received 39 Stripes for our _____; (3rd Place) = When they put a _____ of Thorns on His head to win back our _____; (4th Place) = When they drove nails into His hands to win back our _____; (5th Place) = When the Roman soldiers drove spikes into His feet to win back our _____; (6th Place) = When they pierced Him (Jesus) in His side on the Cross - this won back our _____; (7th Place) = When He a bruise and chastised for our sins - this won back our deliverance and healing for inner hurts and iniquities.

THE RISEN CHRIST, FAITH'S REALITY: (1 Corinthians 15:1-10 (NLT))

- The gospel of Christ should have absolute preeminence and _____ in the life of the Christian and the life of the Church.
- Here is the standard by which every definition of the gospel must be measured. It must include four elements: Christ's _____, burial, and _____ as well as the testimony of the witnesses of Resurrection.

- The Resurrection of Christ is our Present and Future Hope (**1 Peter 1:3 - 5**)
- The world puts its hope in things that can *die*, be *destroyed*, *decay*, or *deteriorate*. Peter by the Holy Spirit reminds us that as Christians that our future is _____ - incorruptible, undefiled, unfading, reserved in heaven because their relationship with God is secure.
- Worldly hope is merely wishful thinking and ends at the grave. Christian hope is based on a Person: the living, resurrected Christ.
