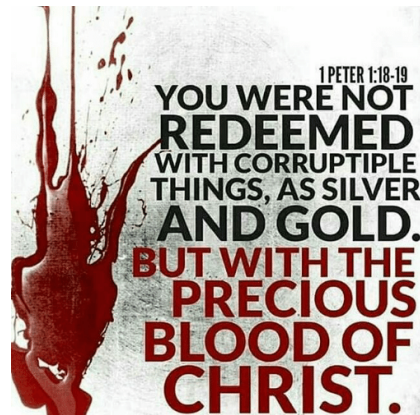

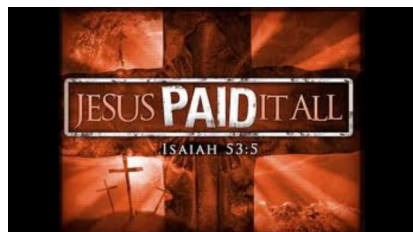

Sermon: "His Death, Our Life; His Blood, Our Redemption!"

1 Corinthians 15:1-10 (NLT) - "Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you **received** and in which you **stand**, ² by which also you are **saved**, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. ³ For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ **died for our sins according to the Scriptures**, ⁴ and that **He was buried**, and that **He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures**, ⁵ and that **He was seen** by Cephas, then by the twelve. ⁶ After that **He was seen** by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. ⁷ After that **He was seen** by James, then by all the apostles. ⁸ Then last of all **He was seen** by me also, as by one born out of due time. ⁹ For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. ¹⁰ But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me."

- When these two men used their wealth to bury Jesus, they illustrated that their hearts were with Jesus. He was their highest priority, so they invested their assets in showing their love for Him.
