<u>Daniel 6:1 - 4 (NKJV)</u> - "It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom one hundred and twenty satraps, to be over the whole kingdom; ² and over these, three governors, of whom Daniel was one, that the satraps might give account to them, so that the king would suffer no loss. 3 Then this Daniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm. 4 So the governors and satraps sought to find some charge against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find no charge or fault, because he was faithful; nor was there any error or fault found in him." ❖ An Excellent Spirit is Christ-like Attitude first and foremost. maintain the measure of maturity and perfection that our ministry must command.

STEPS TO EXCELLENCE IN MINISTRY:

- <u>Step One:</u> It's Your Decision (1) Find your place in the Body (2) Devote yourself to pleasing God and (3) Commit yourself to a life of prayer.
- <u>Step Two</u>: Singleness of Purpose. Our single purpose in ministry, from the Lord is to meet the needs of people. We must not hesitate to step out on our faith personally and publically. We must commit to making the Word of God our final authority and to preach the Word in season and out of season.
- Step Three: Follow the Leadership of the Holy Spirit. In either pulpit or helps ministry, never follow the path your mind wants to take. Don't lean to your own understanding. Learn to follow the leadership of the Holy Spirit within you. Don't be influenced by situations. Be prepared for disturbances or distractions sent by the enemy.
- Step Four: Strip Away the Things of the World. (Read John 17:16 17 (NKJV)). To sanctify means "to separate unto." We are in this world but not of it. So to have excellence of ministry, we must strip away everything of the world from our lives until there is nothing left but the Word of God. One of the first things that must be rooted out is our sin. Second, strip away your negative confessions. Do away with Spiritual Junk Food. Put away Man-made schemes. Lay aside the cares of this world.
- Step Five: Look to the Word Day and Night. (Read Proverbs 4:5 9 NKJV). The Word Promotes! Looking to the Word helps control your flesh. God will exalt you as you exalt the Word.
- Step Six: Spend Time Fasting. Two types of fasts: (1) A <u>Proclaimed</u> fast and (2) a <u>Personal</u> fast.
