<u>D</u>	aniel $6:1-4$ (NKJV) - "It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom one hundred and twenty satraps, to be over the whole kingdom; and over
th	ese, three governors, of whom Daniel was one, that the satraps might give account to them, so that the king would suffer no loss. 3 Then this
D	aniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because <u>an excellent spirit</u> was in him; and the king gave thought to setting
hi	m over the whole realm. 4 So the governors and satraps sought to find some charge against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could
	nd no charge or fault, because <u>he was faithful</u> ; nor was there any error or fault found in him."
**	An Excellent Spirit is Christ-like Attitude first and foremost. TRUE HUMILITY IS DEPENDENT! Humility is
	a huge part of an spirit.
**	True humility doesn't exalt self. True humility doesn't debase self. True humility isn't about self at all. Self is pride. The need to
	share your opinion is pride. Slandering or gossiping about someone to improve your reputation is pride. Avoiding criticism is pride.
	Worrying about what other people think is pride. (Read Numbers 12:3 NKJV) True humility is saying about yourself what God says
	about you. True humility agrees with God.
*	An excellent spirit or attitude is the key to Yet many people think that as long as they do the right thing, they will
	succeed. They think that going through the motions of success will bring success. But that's not true. WRONG ATTITUDE VOIDS
	RIGHT ACTIONS. (Read 1 Corinthians 13:1 – 3 NKJV) – Speaking in tongues, using your faith, and giving to the poor are all good
	things. But doing "good things" without the right motivation – without the God's kind of love – is worthless. It profits nothing.
**	Mimicking the actions of biblical heroes like Daniel, Joseph, and Paul without the heart that produced those actions leads to frustration,
	and ultimately failure. That's because in God's kingdom, the behind a person's action is more important than the
	action itself. Proverbs 21:2 (NKJV) - "Every way of a man is right in his own eyes, but the LORD weighs the hearts."
*	A PERSON WITH RIGHT MOTIVATION IS A PERSON OF Integrity does what's right when everyone is
	watching, as well as when no one is watching. Integrity is consistent. It does not compromise.
*	Compromise is a big problem in today's society. People tend not to have strong convictions about anything. Compromise is the language
	of the devil. Whatever you compromise to get or to keep – including "peace" – you'll eventually lose. But God honors conviction that based
	on the integrity and truth of His Word.
*	Read Daniel 3:1 – 18 (NKJV). These men not only did the right thing by refusing to compromise and refusing to bow, but they also told
٠,	the king in no uncertain terms, "We're not worried. Your threats are not a big deal. We aren't afraid of what you can do to us." What an
	attitude! They just obeyed God and refused to compromise their convictions (Exodus 20:3 – 5)
*	Proverbs 29:25 (NKJV) - "The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the LORD shall be safe." (NLT) - "Fearing people is a
	dangerous trap" If you're afraid of man, you will fall into a snare. You'll always compromise and feed pressured and criticized. But when
	God is your source, when He is your ultimate authority, you understand the psalmist's declaration that "The Lord is on my side; I will not
	fear: what can man do unto me?" – Psalm 118:6 (KJV). As believers, we've got to stop worrying about what other people think. We have to
	stop living to please man. When speaking the truth in love or speaking a Word from God, we don't tell a person the truth because
	we're afraid they'll reject it, we've just rejected the truth for them. We need to love people enough to tell them the truth. Truth is what
40	sets people free. (John 8:32)
