The unconditional, unfailing and unlimited love of God! • Scriptural Descriptions of the Love of God (Agape): Read 1 John 3:11 - 23			
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 We take from these verses that The Love of God is and not 			
NATURAL HUMAN Love – which is <u>SELFISH</u> .			
• Read 1 John 4:7 – 12: We learn from these verses that the Love of God is a			
and not a FEELING . We choose to LOVE and we choose to FORGIVE.

We learn three more important aspects of the Love of God:			
 LOVE is It is an intense, eager yearning to do good. 			
 LOVE is a It is the commitment to meet the needs of another 			
without asking or expecting anything in return.			
 LOVE is It is anticipating the needs of another and meeting them.

1 Corinthians 13:4 (NKJV) – "Love suffers long"			
 LOVE, BY DEFINITION, SUFFERS LONG. The concept of longsuffering comes 			
from two Greek words that mean EVEN TEMPERATURE. These words refer to something			
that takes a long time to boil and they form the foundation for our word

Ephesians 4:26 (NKJV) –"Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath"			
There is a lot of negativity in our world today. People are, IMPATIENT

They give us the ability to dominate and control our			
 and RUDE. Say one wrong word and they fly off the handle. Research shows that there's a new phenomenon called "<u>INTERNET</u>," They've found that <u>ANGER IS THE MOST VIRAL EMOTION ON SOCIAL MEDIA</u>. 			

•	We all	should live and <u>CONSTRAINED</u> by the LOVE of CHRIST	
	to regu	larly practice this Biblical "Sunset Rule". Because, when we go more than a day	
	with Unresolved Anger we either become HOMICIDAL or SUICIDAL.		
•	THE DEAL IS THAT EVIL EMOTIONS ARE A SIN AND SHOULD BE TREATED AS SUCH.

		and angry and mad at others. Don't yell at one another or curse each other or ever	
	be rude. ³² Instead, be kind and merciful, and forgive others, just as God forgave you		
	because of Christ." Be kind; be nice. The opposite of being kind is being

	THAT MAKES SOMEONE FEEL IS EVIL.		
•	When people HURT you two things occur:		
	0	(1) The <u>ACTION (ACT)</u> – Forgiveness deals with the

	0	Walking in Forgiveness is a part of Walking in Love. Forgiveness should be	
		practiced: (1) (2) <u>PROACTIVELY</u> and (3) <u>REACTIVELY</u> .	
	0	"A lot of people think you can wait until tomorrow [to forgive	
		someone]. You can't; you don't have the time. That thing [anger,	
		hatred] starts growing so fast. If that happens, you might not be	
		able to control it." - James E. "Johnny" Johnson	
	0	Forgiveness Process in Dealing the Trespass of Others: (1) Let it drop (2) Leave it	
		(3) Let it go (4) Give up the resentment.	
	0	(2) The <u>ATTITUDE</u> – We have to do something to deal with	
	0	The Bible says whatever we we take away the ability for it to <u>HURT</u>	
		you. 1 Peter 3:9 (NLT) – "Don't repay evil for evil. Don't retaliate with insults	
		when people insult you. Instead, pay them back with a blessing. That is what	
		God has called you to do, and he will grant you his blessing."	
THE IMPORTANCE OF KINDNESS			
1 Corinthians 13:4 (NKJV) – "Love suffers long and is kind" Paul doesn't stop with his			
description of longsuffering in 1 Corinthians 13:4 but proceeds to introduce, the			
2 nd of the fifteen qualities of the LOVE of God.			
•	• During this strategic description, he suggests that <u>LONGSUFFERING</u> is paired closely		
	with When he writes this, he immediately blows our cover.		
It helps to think about the connection between LONGSUFFERING and KINDNESS in this			
	•	LONGSUFFERING lives <u>inside</u> of us; KINDNESS is displayed on the <u>outside</u> .	
	0	LONGSUFFERING is your <u>attitude</u> ; KINDNESS is reflected in your <u>actions</u> .	
	0	LONGSUFFERING is what <u>God sees;</u> KINDNESS is what <u>others see</u> .
