SERMON TITLE: "Redeemed and Restored In Christ!"

Ephesians 1:7 (NKJV) - "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace"

(NLT) – "He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the **blood of his Son** and forgave our sins"

1 Peter 2:18 - 19 (NKJV) - "18 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers. 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."

	the truth and the truth shall make you free," - <u>John 8:32</u> . The truth will not help you if you do not know it. You mustwhat God has done for you.

There are three simple, yet powerful statements made in Galatians 3:13. Let's take a closer look. - 1st - The first fact is that you are

for	you. In other words, Christ took your curse so you could go free.
•	3 rd –: Psalms 107:2 (NKJV) – "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so,
	Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy; Colossians 1:13 (NKJV) – "He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love."
•	4th –: Isaiah 51:11 – "Therefore the redeemed of the Lord shall return, and
	come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away."; Did you know that as a believer you've been from the curse of grief and sorrow by the blood of Jesus Christ? The enemy of your soul will begin to attack your with grief and sorrow even before you lose a loved one, lose your job or business, or lose your good health.
•	You and I have been <u>REDEEMED</u> from grief and sorrow and we have to it just like you have to resist the temptations to sin. YOU ARE THE REDEEMED! You shouldn't partake of anything but !
•	Jesus paid much too high a price for your freedom for you to stay bound with grieving
	and sorrowing. It is an insult to God for you to stay in prison when Jesus paid the price for your release. Satan cannot hold you. Sin cannot hold you. The past cannot hold you. Read Isaiah 61:1 - 3.

IN CHRIST YOU HAVE BEEN AND ALL (RIGHTEOUS) THINGS HAVE BEEN RESTORED!:

- Psalm 51:12 (NKJV) "Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit."; Psalms 23:3 (NKJV) - "He restores my soul..."
- Isaiah 57:18 (NKJV) "I have seen his ways, and will heal him; I will also lead him, and restore comforts to him and to his mourners."
- Nahum 2:2 (NKJV) "For the Lord will restore the excellence of Jacob..."
- Jeremiah 30:17 (NKJV) "For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds..."
- **RESTORE** = to bring back; to recover; to refresh; to relieve; to compensate; to recompense.
