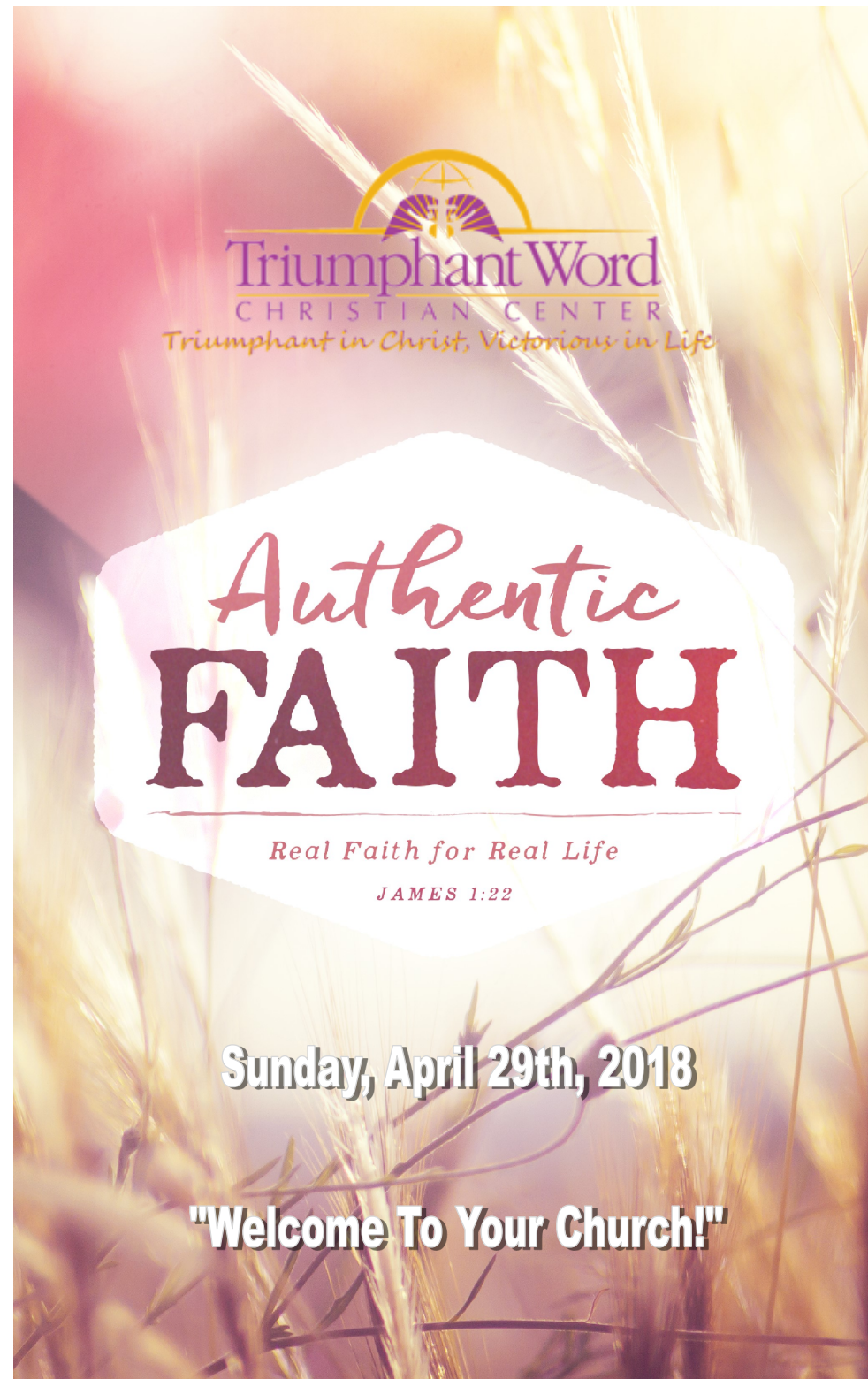
Special Announcements:

SERMON NOTES (CONTINUED...)

SERMON TITLE: *“Can Your Faith Be Heard?”*

- FAITH BY SAYING AND BY PRAYING: (Mark 11:22 - 24 NKJV).

- This has to do with “Saying”. This is how Jesus is telling us how to deal with our mountains.
- You’ve got to believe what you’re SAYING and believe that you receive when you PRAY.
- *CONFESSION builds the road over which faith carries its mighty cargo - E.W. Kenyon*
- A spiritual law few recognize is that our CONFESSION _____ us.
- *If you’re not happy with what you have in your life, check up on what you’ve been saying - Kenneth E. Hagin*

- People need to stop saying what they have but start having what they say.
- Faith will never rise above the level of your _____. God can be no bigger in you than you _____ Him to be.
- *Many Christians are weak, though sincere, because they lack a bold confession of who they are in Christ. - Kenneth E. Hagin*

- GOD HAS ORDAINED STRENGTH TO COME OUT OF YOUR MOUTH TO STOP THE ENEMY OF SIN, SICKNESS, SATAN AND SORROW FROM DEFEATING YOU!

- *The confession of your lips that has grown out of faith in your heart will absolutely defeat the adversary in every combat. - E.W. Kenyon*
- The Word will heal you if you will continually confess it. You can school yourself into faith through confessing the Word out loud to yourself. Nothing will establish and build your faith as quickly as confession. (**Romans 10:8 NKJV** - *"But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach)"*)

- Matthew 17:20 (NKJV)** - "So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, **you will say** to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."

- **IF YOU HAVE FAITH YOU WOULD HAVE SAID... Luke 17:6 - 8 (YLT)** - “and the Lord said, ‘If ye had faith as a grain of mustard, **ye would have said** to this sycamore, Be uprooted, and be planted in the sea, and it would have obeyed you.’⁷ But, who is he of you -- having a servant ploughing or feeding -- who, to him having come in out of the field, **will say**, Having come near, recline at meat?⁸ but will not [rather] **say to him**, Prepare what I may sup, and having girded thyself about, minister to me, till I eat and drink, and after these things thou shalt eat and drink?”
