NEW SERMON SERIES: "Going Forward in Faith"

SERMON TITLE: "Can Your Faith Be Heard?"

<u>Mark 11:22 - 24 (NKJV)</u> – "²² So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. ²³ For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. ²⁴ Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."

- In these verses, our Lord and Master outlines very powerful principles of the law of faith that we will most assuredly need in the season and hour in which we live. Faith is so, so important for us to live and walk by: (Read <u>2 Corinthians 5:7; Romans 1:16 - 17; Galatians</u> <u>3:11; Hebrews 10:38</u>)
- Two very, very vitally important things we should monitor to ensure we are constantly growing and developing in are: (1) Our ______Walk and (2) Our ______Walk.
- Our faith must continue to grow and develop. When our faith grows and develops three things occur: (1) Satan's dominion over us ______; (2) Circumstances become less ______; and (3) ______ is destroyed.
- Our faith grows by: (1) _____ and (2) _____ it. Romans
 <u>10:17 (NKJV)</u> "So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God."
- IT HAS BEEN SAID THAT THE DOOR TO THE SUPERNATURAL SWINGS ON TWO HING-ES _______AND ______. 2 Corinthians 4:13 (NKJV) - "And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak," Can your FAITH be heard?
- Believing is the ______ of Faith; Speaking is an essential ______ of Faith.
 HOLD FAST TO YOUR CONFESSION: Read Hebrews 4:14 (NKJV)
- In the Greek, the word for profession and the word for confession is the same, "homologia". It means "to say the same thing; to agree with; an acknowledgment or profession." It is more than just speaking. It is a ______ which affects every facet of life.
- A true Christian believer and follower of Christ does not just practice faith on the weekends, but lives it daily. As a Christian, your CONFESSION is your _____!
- Your faith will never rise above your level of ______.
- You must get a grip on your lip and not let it slip in other words; on your possession should be your faith's ______.
- Faith's confession creates reality. (<u>Read Romans 10:8 10</u>). <u>Hebrews 10:23 (KJV</u>) "Let us hold fast the **profession of our faith** without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised.)"

• Types of New Testament Confessions we should do:

(1) **The _____ Confession: Jesus Is Lord!** (Romans 10:9, 10). A fundamental practice in your Christian faith is both the *initial* and *continual* confession that Jesus Christ is Lord. He is Supreme Authority. The overriding emphasis is that He is Victor!

(2) **The Confession of** _____: **Restoration, Fellowship, and Possession** (<u>1 John</u> <u>1:9</u>). Faith trembles in the darkness of broken fellowship. 1 John 1:9 is written to the Christian who still has a *relationship* with God, but has sinned and lost that *fellowship* he or she once enjoyed. Sin breaks fellowship. This kind of confession is where we repent and turn from sin. Broken fellowship separates you from God's presence and the supernatural power, peace, protection and provision He has given to His children. Sin goes out by way of the mouth and righteousness comes in by way of the mouth. You confess your sin by acknowledging and admitting it to Him through your own lips.

(3) The Confession of _____: What we Believe or What we are Believing to See / Receive (Hebrews 4:14)

- (1) <u>Boldly Confess</u>: What God has done for us in the death, burial and resurrection of Christ.

- (2) Boldly Confess: Who we are now in Christ and what we have in Him.
- (3) Boldly Confess: What Jesus is doing now for us in Heaven.
- (4) <u>Boldly Confess</u>: What God by the Word and the Holy Spirit can do in us now.

SERMON TITLE: "Can Your Faith Be Heard?"

• FAITH BY SAYING AND BY PRAYING: (Mark 11:22 - 24 NKJV).

- This has to do with "Saying". This is how Jesus is telling us how to deal with our mountains.
- You've got to believe what you're SAYING and believe that you receive when you PRAY.
- CONFESSION builds the road over which faith carries its mighty cargo E.W. Kenyon
- A spiritual law few recognize is that our CONFESSION ______ us.
- If you're not happy with what you have in your life, check up on what you've been saying -Kenneth E. Hagin
- People need to stop saying what they have but start having what they say.
- Faith will never rise above the level of your _____. God can be no bigger in you than you _____ Him to be.
- Many Christians are weak, though sincere, because they lack a bold confession of who they are in Christ. Kenneth E. Hagin

- The Word will heal you if you will continually confess it. You can school yourself into faith through confessing the Word out loud to yourself. Nothing will establish and build your faith as quickly as confession. (Romans 10:8 NKJV "But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach)"
- Your success and usefulness in this world is measured by your confession and the tenacity with which you hold fast to that confession. F.F. Bosworth

- <u>Matthew 17:20 (NKJV)</u> "So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, <u>you will say</u> to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."
