



NEW SERMON SERIES: "Going Forward in Faith"

SERMON TITLE: "Can Your Faith Be Heard? - Part 2"

Mark 11:22 - 24 (NKJV) – "22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and

eve	s not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have what- r he says. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you eive them, and you will have them."
•	In these verses, our Lord and Master outlines very powerful principles of the law of faith that we will most assuredly need in the season and hour in which we live. Faith is so, so important for us to live and walk by: (Read <u>2 Corinthians 5:7; Romans 1:16 - 17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38</u> )
•	Two very, very vitally important things we should monitor to ensure we are constantly growing and developing in are: (1) OurWalk and (2) OurWalk.
•	Our faith must continue to grow and develop. When our faith grows and develops three things occur: (1) Satan's dominion over us; (2) Circumstances become less; and (3) is destroyed.
•	Our faith grows by: (1) and (2) it. Romans 10:17 (NKJV) - "So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God."
•	IT HAS BEEN SAID THAT THE DOOR TO THE SUPERNATURAL SWINGS ON TWO HING- ES AND 2 Corinthians 4:13  (NKJV) - "And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed
	and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak." Can your FAITH be heard?
• WH	Believing is the of Faith; Speaking is an essential of Faith.  AT IS YOUR SPEAKER SAYING?: Read Hebrews 4:14 (NKJV)
•	In the Greek, the word for profession and the word for confession is the same, "homologia". It means "to say the same thing; to agree with; an acknowledgment or profession." It is more than just speaking. It is a which affects every facet of life.
•	A true Christian believer and follower of Christ does not just practice faith on the weekends, but lives it daily. As a Christian, your CONFESSION is your!

	Read John 14:10 - 14 (NKJV): Like our Heavenly Father and our Lord Jesus, our faith is to work as well through (1) Working the Word and (2) Allowing the Word to work for us.  - We are to allow and enable God to use our faith to: (1) (2) To and (3) To Control things in our life that expands His Kingdom and brings Him glory.  - WORDS are the most powerful thing in the Universe! Words can heal or hurt. Words bless or curse. Words can help or hinder you. (Read Matthew 12:33 - 37 (NKJV))  - In John 14:13 - 14, Jesus reveals one of three key activities / aspects of what the eaking Part of our Faith should be doing.
THE dark We	(1) We are to the <u>Subject</u> (Person, Place or Thing) E <u>COMMAND</u> OF FAITH. (Read John 14:13 - 14). Through faith-filled words we dominate kness, demons, disease, discouragement and depression that tries to hinder and harass us! must speak the FAITH COMMAND to mountains in our lives. (Boldness is required).
( <u>Jar</u>	(2) We are to about the <u>Situation</u> . Faith's confession ates reality. <u>Hebrews 10:23 (KJV)</u> - "Let us hold fast the <u>profession of our faith</u> without waing; (for he is faithful that promised.)" - THE <u>CONFESSION</u> OF FAITH  (3) We get to to the Savior. <u>Read Luke 18:1 - 6 (NKJV)</u> - E <u>CRY</u> OF FAITH (For <u>Justice</u> or <u>Mercy</u> in the Courtroom of Heaven) ( <u>Romans 8:31 - 35</u> ) mes 5:1 - 4) (Example of Children of Israel in Egypt).  TH BY SAYING: (Mark 11:22 - 23 NKJV).
•	This has to do with "Saying". This is how Jesus is telling us how to deal with our mountains.
•	You've got to (1) believe in our HEART and (2) believe what you're SAYING.

•	People need to stop saying what they have but start having what they say.

SERMON TITLE: "Can Your Faith Be Heard? - Part 2"

•	You've got to believe that you receive when you PRAY.
•	GRACE, FAITH Faith what Grace has
)	We must realize that things have to be in the spiritual realm. FAITH takes back what the Devil has stolen from you. By FAITH we have to reach out and them.
•	Salvation is an example. Did any of you get saved and born again without reaching out and taking what God was offering you? Did salvation just fall on you? Or did you respond and reach out and take the gift God was offering you in salvation.
•	We must develop our "Faith Response" to receive God's gracious gifts and promises! What about in addition to receiving and taking SALVATION, the Gift of the Holy Spirit? What about receiving and taking your HEALING? What about the exceeding great and precious promises of God? (2 Peter 1:3)
	Remember, DESIRE + PRAYER + BELIEVE THAT YOU RECEIVE THEM = YOU WILL HAVE THEM. (Mark 11:24).
	Someone wrote that the word "Receive" in <u>Mark 11:24</u> could be translated " <u>take with force</u> or " <u>seize with a grip that cannot be shaken loose</u> ."
	RECEIVE what God has for you. How? By reaching up in faith and taking it!
	If your faith is not strong enough to move your mouth, it will never be strong enough to mov your mountain Mark Hankins
HE	ECOMMUNICATION OF YOUR FAITH (Read Philemon 6 (KJV))
	Learn and remember the our Father God used His Words to create the Universe ( <a href="Hebrews">Hebrews</a> 11:1 - 3) Our Father God uses His faith to: (1) <a href="Create">Create</a> (2) to <a href="Cause">Cause</a> and (3) to <a href="Control">Control</a> things.
	Learn to use that work for you. Learn that your lips can make you a (rich person) or a pauper (poor person). Your words can make you healed and whole or make you (physically or mentally infirmed).
	Learn that your lips make you wanted or despised. Your lips can make you a victor or hold you as a captive (victim).
	Your words can be filled with faith and love and breath the very fragrance of heaven; or you can fill your words with fear, doubt and hatred and fill the very atmosphere of your life with the poison of hell.
	It is through faith-filled WORDS that we release and exercise <u>the authority</u> we possess in Christ in and over the situations and circumstances of our life:
