#### SERMON NOTES FOR SUNDAY, July 1st, 2018

SERMON SERIES: "Stay In Your Lane!" SERMON TITLE: "Serve The Lord With Gladness" Psalms 100:2a (NKJV) - "Serve the LORD with gladness..." Romans 12:11 AMPC - "Never lag in zeal and in earnest endeavor; be aglow and burning with the Spirit, serving the Lord." Romans 14:17 - 18 (NKJV) - "17For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. 18 For he who serves Christ in these things is acceptable to God and ap-Philippians 4:4 AMPC - "Rejoice in the Lord always [delight, gladden yourselves in Him]; again I say, Reioice!' REJOICE = (Greek - "chairo" which means (1) to be cheerful (2) to be glad (3) joy (4) rekindle/stir up the joy by rejoicing exceedingly (5) re-joying/refilling your joy). THE HOLY SPIRIT PROMPTS US TO SO WE CAN BE FILLED WITH HIM. WHY DO YOU HAVE TO BE CONTINUALLY FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT? BECAUSE YOU LEAK! We require a continuous refilling, refueling so to speak. Everyone acts different when they are filled with the Holv Spirit. Psalm 89:15 – 16 (NLT) – "Happy are those who hear the joyful call to worship for they will walk in the light of your presence, Lord. They rejoice all day long in your wonderful reputation. They exult in your righteousness." Nehemiah 8:10 (MSG) – "This day is holy to God. Don't feel bad. The joy of God is your strength!" IF YOU HAVE NO JOY, YOU HAVE NO STRENGTH: IF YOU HAVE NO STRENGTH. YOU CAN'T RE-SIST SIN, SATAN, SICKNESS OR SORROW. IF YOU CAN'T RESIST YOU DON'T WIN! REJOICING REJECTERS AND REJOICING REFUSERS: WE MUST MAKE A CHOICE DAILY TO REJOICE! C.S. LEWIS once said "Joy and rejoicing is the serious business of heaven." Psalm 100:1 - 2 (NKJV) - "Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all you lands! Serve the Lord with gladness, come before His Presence with singing.' Some people are fully of joy at church and as soon as they leave church, they return to being moody, \_\_\_\_\_. What happened? They \_ Too often, they didn't learn to or they forgot to \_ Consider this thought per Old and New Testament Scripture. IS A REQUIRED REGIMEN AND ROUTINE OF THE BELIEVER. 1 Thessalonians 5:16 (NKJV) - "Rejoice always," Philippians 3:1 (NKJV) – "Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord." YOU CAN'T BE ANY CLOSER TO JESUS THAN YOU ARE YIELDED TO THE HOLY SPIRIT. Acts 13:52 (AMPC) - "And the disciples were continually filled [throughout their souls] with joy and the Holy Spirit.' Some People Who Resist or Refuse to Rejoice: (1) The Ungrateful ( know that people can identify exactly how successful or unsuccessful you are the moment you open your mouth? When we open and out comes nothing but complain, we convince other people that we are not in control. Complaining is a subconscious way of expressing you are powerless to change your cir-Philippians 2:14 (AMPC) - "Do all things without grumbling and faultfinding and complaining [against God] and questioning and doubting [among yourselves] ) - Theodore Roosevelt once said that "COMPARISON IS THE THIEF OF JOY." Pastor Steven Furtick once said "The reason why we struggle with insecurity is because our behind the scene's with everyone else's highlight reel." The best way to enjoy your own life is to stop comparing it to others.

(3) The Unsatisfied in an ungodly way (\_\_\_\_\_\_) – To covet means to be in a state of discontent. To be CONTENT means to be without COVETEOUSNESS and INWARDLY SUFFICIENT. Where contentment ends, covetousness begins. Covetousness drives you to achieve <u>monetary</u>, <u>material</u>, <u>marriage</u> and family, <u>business and career</u>, or <u>ministry</u> success without God help, wisdom, power or grace.
