<u>Acts 5:29 (NKJV)</u> – "But Peter and the other apostles answered and said. "We ought to **obey** God rather than men."

<u>Titus 3:1 (NKJV)</u> – "Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities; **to obey**, to be ready for every good work."

<u>1 Peter 1:13 - 16 (NKJV)</u> – "¹³ Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; ¹⁴ as **obedient children**, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; ¹⁵ but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, ¹⁶ because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

But instead of _______ the Lord, we read in verse 9 (<u>1</u> Samuel 15:9 NKJV) "⁹But Saul and the people spared Agag and the best of the sheep, the oxen, the fatlings, the lambs, and all that was good, and were unwilling to utterly destroy them. But everything despised and worthless, that they utterly destroyed."
- Even if Saul's intentions had been pure, he still _____ God's decree and specific directions. First, Saul openly _____ the commands of the Lord. Secondly, he began to _____ the people. - <u>CONNECTION BETWEEN OBEDIENCE AND FAITH</u>: <u>Read Mark 11:23 26</u> and <u>Galatians 5:6</u> (WITHOUT OBEDIENCE, GOD CANNOT TRUST US WITH HIS POWER!)
 - Walking In Love: (1) Making the <u>CHOICE</u> (2) Showing true <u>COMPASSION</u> (3)
 Demonstrating unwavering <u>COMMITMENT</u> and (4) Displaying consistent <u>CARING</u>
 - Walking In Forgiveness: Read Luke 17:1 6 (KJV) (1) Practicing in Instant Forgiveness and Unconditional Love (2) Removing Roots of Bitterness -Ephesians 4:31 - 32 (NKJV) – "Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."
