God's Authority. We've said numerous times on Wednesday night in our "Triumphant	
Church" teachings that one important thing to embrace is this: "If you're not

HUMBLE SUBMISSION: A BIG KEY	
James 4:6 - 7 (NKJV) - "But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud but	
gives grace to the humble ." Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you."	
James 4:10 (NKJV) – "Humble yourselves in sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up." 1 Peter 5:5 – 7 (NKJV) – "⁵ Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes,	
all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility , for "God resists the proud,	
but gives grace to the humble ." ⁶ Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God,
