

## Sermon Handout Notes: "Are You Avoiding the Trap of Offense?" - 11/18/2018

Luke 17:1 (KJV) – "Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come! <sup>2</sup> It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones. <sup>3</sup> Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. <sup>4</sup> And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him. <sup>5</sup> And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith. <sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you."

## INTRODUCTION:

- We shared that one of the underlying themes of the entire Word of God is \_
- We can't receive salvation without <u>OBEDIENCE</u> Repent, Believe the Gospel. (<u>Romans</u> <u>10:9 10, 13</u>). When we hear the good news of the truth of gospel of Christ, it requires to enjoy the benefits of it. To receive forgiveness of our sins, requires <u>OBEDIENCE</u>. <u>1 John 1:9 (NKJV)</u> "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." To experience and enjoy the blessings of The Lord, the prerequisite of \_\_\_\_\_\_ has to be applied.
- We showed through Scriptural examples of Cain and Abel and King Saul that it is vital to <u>INSTANTLY</u> Divine Instruction. Because, <u>DELAYED</u> OBEDIENCE IS DISOBEDIENCE – BECAUSE DIRECTION AND TIMING ARE CRITICAL. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE "HARKEN DILIGENTLY" TO THE LORD'S DIVINE INSTRUCTIONS AND DIRECTIVES. WE MUST <u>INSTANTLY</u> OBEY! <u>PARTIAL</u> OBEDIENCE IS JUST ANOTHER FORM OF DISOBEDIENCE – COMPLETE DISOBEDIENCE.
- We also discovered that obedience is both an \_\_\_\_\_ and an \_\_\_\_\_
- <u>OBEDIENCE</u> will always bring you victory. <u>OBEDIENCE</u> is the key place of <u>prosperity</u>, <u>peace</u> and <u>protection</u> in our lives.

  - Job 36:11 (NKJV) "If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures."

	ensnares small animals. It means to cause to stumble or entice to sin.
	<ul> <li>3<sup>rd</sup> We must take heed to ourselves; especially when you encounter</li> </ul>
	relational schisms; get into bad arguments; strife or just somebody did
	you wrong (e.g. destructive criticism; harmful complaints; condemn you
	harshly). WE MUST MAKE SURE WE "LOVINGLY CONFRONT" THEM.
