Power Answer and Points to "Praise and Thanksgiving":

- How often should we PRAISE the Lord? <u>Psalms 113:3</u> "From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the Lord's name is to be praised."
- PRAISE is the easiest way to remove mountains and overcome difficulties. PRAISE will get your eyes off the conflict and onto the Conqueror.
- PRAISE lifts us up to another dimension in God's grace where our attention is not focused on the dilemma, but on our <u>Deliver</u>, the Lord Jesus Christ.
- PRAISE helps keep the flesh in check. PRAISING God helps us overcome negative emotions that may try to dominate us. PRAISING God helps our spirits stay in control instead of our flesh or our emotions taking over and dominating. (<u>Read Ephesians 6:10</u>; <u>Colossians 3:1-17</u>).
- PRAISING God in the midst of any situation encourages our faith and causes us to be able to rise above any situation or circumstance, no
 matter what it is. PRAISE keeps us from getting ensnared in the complexities of the problem and helps us get caught up in God instead!

- PRAISE strengthens your faith (<u>Read Romans 4:20, 21</u>). How strong or strengthened is your faith? We must practice and learn to stand on God's Word and PRAISE Him for our victory BEFORE we see the answer or physical evidence of it. THIS IS REAL SOLUTION FOR WEAKNESS AND ANXIETY!
- Our PRAISE to God will turn our sadness and sorrow to gladness, our defeat to victory, our weakness to strength and our trials to triumphs!
 <u>Psalms 43:5 (KJV)</u> "Why art thou cast down, O my soul? And why art thou disquieted within me? Hope in God: for I shall yet praise Him, Who is the health of my countenance, and my God."
- <u>THE PRAISE WALK</u>: Learn to walk every day in the life of ______ God. Walking in the ______ life is walking in victory. Don't let a day go by that you don't lift your voice in PRAISE to the Lord: "...His praise shall continually be in my mouth." <u>Psalms 34:1</u>. Also, PRAISING God is being a _______ of the Word (<u>James 1:22</u>), and the Bible says the doer of the Word shall be blessed in his deeds (<u>James 1:25</u>). Consider something else: Jesus our Lord, already defeated the enemy at the Cross of Calvary (Colossians). - <u>PRAISE has been ordained to silence and muzzle the enemy</u>: <u>Psalms 8:2 (NKJV)</u> "Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength, because of Your enemies, that You may silence the enemy and the avenger." STRENGTH TO SILENCE AND SHUT THE ENEMY'S MOUTH
- <u>The Ten (10) Lepers</u>: (Read Luke 17:11 19) HEALING and WHOLENESS
- Blessing and Sanctifying Food: (Read 1 Corinthians 14:16 17; 1 Timothy 4:4 5) BLESSING FOOD
