- **Philippians 2:9 – 11 (NKJV)** – “⁹ Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”
- **Hebrews 1:1 - 6 (NKJV)** – “God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, ² has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds; ³ who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴ having become so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they. ⁵ For to which of the angels did He ever say: “You are My Son, today I have begotten You”? And again: “I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son”? ⁶ But when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says: “Let all the angels of God worship Him.”
- **Ephesians 1:20 – 23 (NKJV)** – “²⁰ which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. ²² And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, ²³ which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.”
- **REVIEW OF HOW JESUS OBTAINED HIS NAME:** The more excellent Name of Jesus came by three means. ^{1st} - Jesus' Name is great because He _____ a great Name (**Hebrews 1:1 – 6**). His Name is great because of His _____ (**Ephesians 1:20 – 23**). His Name is great because it was _____ upon Him (**Philippians 2:9 – 11**). The measure of the Lord Jesus Christ's ability is the measure of the _____ of that Name, and all that is invested in that Name belongs to us, for Jesus gave us the unqualified use of His Name. Legally, spiritually Jesus gave us the Power of Attorney (the legal right) to _____. His great Name! We as the Church have been _____ to USE the Name of Jesus. – **Read Mark 16:17 – 18 (NKJV).**
- **Read Colossians 2:1 – 10 (NKJV):** Our Father God has made this _____ for the benefit of the Church; He has made this _____ on which the Church has a right to draw for our every need. He has given to Jesus the Name that has within it the _____ of the Godhead, the wealth of the Eternities, and love of the heart of our Father God: and, that Name is given to us.
 - We have a right to USE THE NAME OF JESUS against our (1) _____, (2) in our _____, and in our (3) _____ and worship.
- **REVIEW OF USING THE NAME OF JESUS:** Are you USING the Name of Jesus? How effectively are you USING your inheritance of the Name of Jesus in these three areas?
 - (#1) IN _____: **Read John 16:23 – 24; Matthew 18:19 - 20** – Jesus not only gives us the USE of His Name in New Covenant prayer, but He also declares that the prayer prayed in His Name will receive His special attention.
 - (#2) IN SPIRITUAL _____: **Read Mark 16:17 – 18; John 14:12 – 14** - The Name of Jesus is to be USED in combat against the unseen forces that surround us. We have _____ in the Name of Jesus against all powers of darkness. The Name of Jesus has ALL of the _____, GLORY and MAJESTY it every had. That Name has lost none of the _____ of the person Who bore it – JESUS!

- (#3) IN THE _____ OF OUR BODIES: **Acts 3:6 (NKJV)** – “Then Peter said, “Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: ***In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth***, rise up and walk.” **Acts 4:12 (NKJV)** – “Nor is there ***salvation*** in any other, for there is ***no other name*** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”
 - **THE NAME OF JESUS IS SALVATION = FULL SAVATION.** The New Birth (being Born Again) and the remission of sins is only _____ of salvation. And if that is as far as you think, you _____ God.
 - **Romans 1:16 (NKJV)** – “For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.”
- The Hebrew and Greek words for “***salvation***” imply the ideas of deliverance, safety, preservation, _____ and soundness. Salvation is the great inclusive word of the Gospel, gathering into itself all the redemptive acts and processes. – Scofield
- When God says ***salvation***, He is talking about more than most people realize. The Gospel of Christ is the power of God unto deliverance. The Gospel of Christ is the power of God unto safety. The Gospel of Christ is the power of God unto preservation. The Gospel is the power of God unto soundness. The Gospel of Christ is the power of God unto _____.
- There is healing in no other name! THE _____ THAT HE HAS ALREADY PROVIDED BECOMES REAL TO US THROUGH HIS NAME. “...***In My Name***, they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover.” Why? Because healing belongs to us. Jesus Christ our Lord provided it in our redemption. By His stripes we were healed! (**1 Peter 2:24**). By His Name and the authority we appropriate and assimilate healing into us and others.
- The Name of Jesus account from Smith Wigglesworth - WE NEED TO KNOW THAT _____ FOR OUR PHYSICAL BODIES IS PART OF PARCEL OF THE GOSPEL OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST. Jesus not only took our sins; He also took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.
 - **Isaiah 53:4-5 (NKJV)** – “*4* Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. *5* But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.”
 - **Read Matthew 8:17 (NKJV)** and **1 Peter 2:24 (NKJV)** – “who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.” ***We also minister to the sick and afflicted in the Name of Jesus: Ref James 5:13 – 16 (NKJV)***
