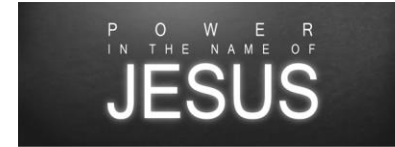


"ALL IN JESUS' NAME"

- **Colossians 3:17 (NKJV)** – “And whatever you do in word or deed, do **all in the name of the Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to God the Father through Him..”
- Whatever we do in _____ or _____ do ALL in the Name of Jesus! **Are you doing ALL in the Name of Jesus?**
If you wash dishes, wash them in the Name of Jesus. If you make the beds, make them in the Name of Jesus. If you teach a class at Church, teach it in the Name of Jesus. If you sing a song, sing it in the Name of Jesus. If you play an instrument, play it in the Name of Jesus. If you go to work and serve customers, serve them in the Name of Jesus. If you work in a factory, a farm or a corporate facility, work in the Name of Jesus. If you do business and business deals, do business and deals in the Name of Jesus.
- That Name, the Name of _____ should be so in our lips and mean so much to us that people outside the Church today would notice how you _____, how you _____ and how you _____ the wonderful and blessed Name of Jesus.
- **WHAT ARE SOME SCRIPTURAL SPECIFICS OF WHAT TO DO IN THE NAME OF JESUS?**
 - (1) GIVE _____ IN THE NAME: **Ephesians 5:20 (NKJV)** – “Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.” The early believers were taught to give thanks unto God for all His _____ in that Name.
 - (2) WASHED, _____, JUSTIFIED IN THAT NAME: **1 Corinthians 6:9 - 11 (NKJV)** – “⁹Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.”
 - Inheriting the Kingdom of God is simply sharing in, participating in and partaking of God’s _____ Presence, Power, Peace, Protection and Provision.
 - (3) GIVE THANKS _____ HIS NAME: **Hebrews 13:15 (NKJV)** – “Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.”
 - (4) _____ IN THE NAME: **James 5:14 (NKJV)** – “Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.”
 - (5) _____ ON THE NAME: **1 John 3:23 (NKJV)** – “And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the Name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as He gave us commandment.” We must _____ on His Name and _____ one another!



“ALL IN JESUS’ NAME” (CONT.)

- **THE NAME OF JESUS IN OUR DAILY WALK:** The Name of Jesus touched every part of the early believers’ _____.
- Like the believers’ in the early church, the Name of Jesus should fill a place in our _____, in our _____, and in the daily _____ of a Christ-like, Christ-honoring life.
- **THREE NECESSARY STEPS TO TAKE DELIVERANCE AND VICTORY OVER DEMONS:** **Ephesians 4:27 [AMPC]** – “*Leave no [such] room or foothold for the devil [give no opportunity to him].*”
 - 1st – Let’s Answer the Question: Can a Christian be possessed by a demon? **ANSWER:** A Christian cannot be taken over _____, soul, and body. So, a Christian cannot be demon possessed. Man is a _____, he possesses a _____ and he lives in a _____ (**1 Thessalonians 5:23**). When one is fully possessed, the devil has take over his _____, his soul (mind) and his body. People can be: (1) _____ (2) _____ or (3) _____ by the devil or demons. The mad man of Gadara, the Bible says, was “possessed” with a devil, and “had” a legion (**Mark 5:9, 15**). He was taken over completely – spirit, soul, and body. But, someone can have a demon and not be _____. In those cases it is in the flesh – the body – or it is in the mind. IN DEALING WITH DEMONS (**MARK 16:17**), SOMETIMES DRIVING OUT OR CASTING OUT DEMONS IS A _____ IN OUR BODY (**ACTS 10:38**) OR AN OBSESSION IN OUR MINDS (E.G. DISCOURAGEMENT, DEPRESSION, DISPAIR) (**ISAIAH 61:1-3**). IF A CHRISTIAN KNOWS HIS _____ AND _____ IN THE NAME OF JESUS AND KNOWS TO USE IT TO KEEP THE DEVIL OUT, HE CANNOT COME IN AND EXERT HIS INFLUENCE. We allow the enemy and demons influence through either: (#1) _____ (by unknowingly or unconsciously yielding to a thought, idea or suggestion of the devil), (2) _____ and (3) _____.
 - 2nd – Three Necessary Steps: (1st) – You must be a _____ of God (Born-again Believer); (2nd) – You must not have any unconfessed _____ in your heart and (3rd) – You must know the _____ of the Name of Jesus – and how to use it.
 - 3rd – The Name of Jesus – and How to USE It: Jesus put and reduced them – the devil, demons and evil spirits – to nothing! And now they are being brought to nothing BY _____. Eventually they are doomed to pass to eternal judgement. But they are being brought to nothing right now, because Jesus defeated them and gave us His Name to _____ against them. “*In My Name, they will exercise authority over them,*” Jesus said (**Mark 16:17**). Another way to say that is, “*In My Name, demons will be rendered useless. They will be brought to nothing.*” **1 Corinthians 2:6 (New English Bible)** – “*...not a wisdom belonging to this passing age, nor to any of its GOVERNING POWERS, WHICH ARE DECLINING TO THEIR END.*”
 - **Moffatt’s Translation** – “*...only it is not the wisdom of this world OR OF THE DETHRONED POWERS WHO RULE THIS WORLD.*”
 - **Young’s Literal Translation** – “*...and wisdom not of this age, NOR OF THE RULERS OF THIS AGE – OF THOSE BECOMING USELESS.*”
