- *“Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that **times of refreshing** may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the **times of restoration** of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.” - **Acts 3:19-21 NKJV***

### **OUR PART TO PARTICIPATE AND COOPERATE IN HIS RESTORATION WORK:**

- It is important for you and I to \_\_\_\_\_ our FAITH in God’s ability and willingness to TURN our CAPTIVITY and RESTORE us by doing three key things:
  - (#1) – By DECREEING and \_\_\_\_\_ it.
  - (#2) – Make your \_\_\_\_\_ conform to God’s Word.
  - (#3) - Your \_\_\_\_\_ must agree with God’s Word.
- Our Father God is ready to \_\_\_\_\_ everything our adversary the devil has stolen from us, to turn any DEVASTATION in our life to RESTORATION. But in order do so He must have someone DECLARE RESTORATION!

### **VICTORY COMES THRU INTERCESSION**

- VICTORY can be facilitated by our effective \_\_\_\_\_.
- **Read Romans 8:26 – 34**
- Notice both the Holy Spirit and the Lord Jesus Christ are \_\_\_\_\_. Why do we need to INTERCEDE or why do we need an INTERCESSOR? **Read Ephesians 6:10 – 18** and **Daniel 10:2 – 13**. The Holy Spirit HELPS us in weakness to INTERCEDE here on earth in prayer and withstanding and standing against the enemy’s resistance and spiritual interference. It is spiritual warfare and spiritual battle at times that we must endure. Jesus our Lord lives in Heaven INTERCEDING for us to our Father God. The Lord Jesus Christ as our Risen Lord and King is right now our Great High Priest. As our Great High Priest in Heaven, He ministers and operates as an \_\_\_\_\_ for us today.
- **Read Hebrews 4:14 – 16**
  - **MEDIATOR (The Only WAY to God): Read John 14:6; Acts 4:12 and 1 Timothy 2:1 - 8**
  - Jesus Christ as the \_\_\_\_\_ of the New Covenant stands ready to: (1) *Connect*, (2) *Commit* and (3) *Confer* the New Covenant to those who believe and receive “The Way of Salvation” (**Acts 9:2; Acts 19:9; Acts 19:23; Acts 24:14; Acts 24:22**). Then, the moment a person accepts Christ as their Lord and personal Savior, Jesus becomes his or her high priestly \_\_\_\_\_! The Bible tells us that He ever lives to make INTERCESSION for believers:
  - **Hebrews 7:25 (NKJV)** – *“Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since **He always lives to make intercession** for them.”*
  - **Romans 8:34 (NKJV)** – *“Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, **Who also makes intercession** for us.”*
    - In the original Greek, the word translated “**Intercession**” is a technical term for approaching a king. Therefore, these Scriptures mean that Christ is seeking the presence and hearing of God on behalf of others.
    - He is there where He ever lives to make \_\_\_\_\_ for us, seeking the hearing of God on our behalf. When we come through Christ, we have a guaranty to get to attention of God. We cannot approach His in any other way except through His Son.
- **In Romans 8 we learn and must understand that:** Everything we need is *in the Spirit*. All the answers we need are *in the Spirit*. Our place of authority in Christ and abundance in Christ is *in the Spirit*. We tap into
