- Our faith grows by: (1) **FEEDING** and (2) **EXERCISING** it. **Romans 10:17 (NKJV)** - “So then faith comes by

hearing and hearing by the word of God.”

YOUR AUTHORITY - YOUR WORDS:

- **SAY OF THE LORD - Psalms 91:1-2 (NKJV)** – “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. ² I will **say of the LORD**, “He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.”
 - To repel the spirit of fear; to enable the Lord to initiate His deliverance.
- **SAY CONTINUALLY - Psalms 35:27 (NKJV)** – “Let them shout for joy and be glad, who favor my righteous cause; and let them **say continually**, “Let the LORD be magnified, Who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”
 - Maintain your confession for prosperity possession.
- **SAY TO THESE THINGS - Romans 8:31 – 32 (NKJV)** – “³¹ What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?”
 - Our proper response and reply to evil and destructive things that happen to us.
- **BOLDLY SAY - Hebrews 13:5-6 (NKJV)** – “⁵ Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.” ⁶ So we may boldly say: “The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”

 - **Matthew 21:22 (NKJV)** – “And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.”
 - **John 16:23 – 24 (NKJV)** – “²³ “And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. ²⁴ Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.”
