•	"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may				
	come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before,				
	whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth				
	of all His holy prophets since the world began." - Acts 3:19-21 NKJV				
•	Friends, these are days of This is a Year of				
•	When Satan steals something from you, God's idea of is not merely to bring you				
	back to your former condition. After He makes the devil pay, your situation will be improved, better,				
	<i>increased</i> , and <i>multiplied</i> !				
•	John 16:13 (NKJV) - "13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth;				
	for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things				
	to come."				
•	In this verse of Scripture, we can glean and ascertain that the Holy Spirit does two things:				
	o (1) He you into all <i>truth.</i>				
	o (2) He you <u>things</u> to come.				
	<ul> <li>What we must understand is that the <u>truth</u> never changes, but <u>things</u> do change.</li> </ul>				
•	The Holy Spirit will lead and guide you in things that in your life, marriage, children, grandchildren				
	and family.				
•	God will lead and guide you in the that change in your life, and you loving your spouse and				
	children, and you leading your family. WE NEED THE HELP OF THE HOLY SPIRIT TO EFFECTIVELY				
	NAVIGATE THROUGH THE THINGS THAT CHANGE IN OUR LIVES. (Read Romans 8:26 – 28)				
•	Psalms 55:19 (NKJV) – "God will hear, and afflict them, even He who abides from of old. Selah Because				
	they do not change, therefore they do not fear God."				
	This verse is referencing griping believers. When you get to the point that you won'tor				
	refuse to, you've lost your reverence for God. Reverence for God accepts and				
	embraces <u>CHANGE!</u>				
	There comes a time in life that things have to We know this from a job or career				
	situation, etc. but what about marriage, a death, a divorce or family situations?				
	Yes, we base the <u>foundation</u> and the <u>framework</u> of our marriage, parenting and leading a				
	family on the bedrock of the <i>truth</i> of God's Word. This places the marriage and the family				
	on a solid spiritual and relational situation.				
	<ul> <li>However, as the couples grow and maturity in their relationship, and as children grow and</li> </ul>				
	develop, a death or divorce or the diagnosis of a debilitating disease, <i>things</i> do <i>change</i> .				
•	Hebrews 12:11 (NKJV) – "Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but				
•	grievous: nevertheless afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised				
	thereby."				
	•				
•	Hebrews 12:6 (NKJV) – "For whom the Lord loves He chastens and scourges every son whom he				
	receives."				
•	God is the best parent ever is saying, in other words, Whom the Lord loves, He <u>chastens</u> and <u>scourges</u> .				
•	<u>Discipline of the Lord includes two things</u> : (1) <b>Chastening</b> – which is discipline; but not all chastening is				
	scourging. There are different forms of chastening/discipline found in the Word. (2) <b>Scourging</b> - Scourging				
	is part of chastening. These prepare us and ready us for theahead.				

- PARENTING WISDOM FROM PROVERBS
  - Proverbs 1:1 (NKJV) "The Proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel"
  - **Proverbs:** Hebrew word is "machele" meaning rule or standard

 Children should eventually develop internal standards that are a result of the Word of God -Remember the (Cycle of Behavior):

Cycle of Behavior	3 Dimensions	
Character	<i>Heart</i> (What we BELIEVE)	God <b>RECREATES</b> our hearts through the New Birth (in Christ)
Choices	<i>Head</i> (How we THINK)	God wants to help us to <b><u>RENEW</u></b> our minds
Conduct	Habits (What we DO)	God wants to help us <u><b>RESHAPE</b></u> our habits
Consequences	Overall <u>HEALTH</u> & Well-being	Not just INFORMED but TRANSFORMED!

- The greatest and most effective way to teach children (aside from the Word of God) is by example
- Wisdom and Instruction: Proverbs 1:2 (NKJV) "To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding." Wisdom and instruction are found together throughout the book of Proverbs
  - o Wisdom comes from *experience*; Wisdom comes from *discipline*
- Disciplines of wisdom: (1) Justice (2) Judgement (3) Equity
- The way that children learn to treat others honestly, fairly and with right judgment and discernment is through both
- Proverbs 1:7 9 (NKJV) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction. My son, hear the instruction of your father, and forsake not the law of your mother: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto your head, and chains about your neck."
  - Verse 8 could be translated "My son, hear the <u>discipline</u> of your father, and forsake not the **teaching** of your mother."
- Ephesians 6:4 (NKJV) "And, you fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord."
  - o fathers: parents; nurture: discipline; admonition: teaching
- <u>Discipline</u>: Teaching must accompany discipline to be effective in a child's life
- Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV) "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it."
- <u>Training</u>: Children need to be trained. *Many parents end up shipwrecked with their children because they simply read the Word and do not live it.* (Read Proverbs 6:20 23 (NKJV))
