



## “RESTORATION OF THE JOY OF HIS SALVATION”

**TWCC Wednesday Night Teaching Handout – Sunday, May 15th, 2019**

*“Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out **my transgressions**. <sup>2</sup>Wash me thoroughly from **my iniquity**, and cleanse me from **my sin**. <sup>3</sup>For I acknowledge **my transgressions**, and **my sin** is always before me. <sup>4</sup>Against You, You only, have I **sinned**, and done **this evil** in Your sight— that You may be found just when You speak, and blameless when You judge. <sup>5</sup>Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me. <sup>6</sup>Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part You will make me to know wisdom. <sup>7</sup>Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. <sup>8</sup>**Make me hear joy and gladness**, that the bones You have broken may **rejoice**. <sup>9</sup>Hide Your face from **my sins**, and blot out all my iniquities. <sup>10</sup>Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. <sup>11</sup>Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup>**Restore to me the joy of Your salvation**, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit.” – **Psalms 51:1 – 12 (NKJV)***

- These are days of \_\_\_\_\_ and Year of **RESTORATION**. This is a season to be RESTORED!
- We see here David’s Prayer of \_\_\_\_\_. We are supposed to live with \_\_\_\_\_ in our Christian life and journey. \_\_\_\_\_ is the serious business of Heaven! – Andrew Murray.
- Satan, \_\_\_\_\_, sickness, sorrow and shame can rob of our JOY if we choose to yield to it or allow it to dominate our lives. In this case David’s \_\_\_\_\_ of adultery and murder caused him to lose His JOY!
- **Romans 6:14 (NKJV)** – “For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.”
  - In other words, \_\_\_\_\_ won’t lord it over you! Sin, Satan, Sickness, Sorrow and Shame are synonymous.

### WHAT IS SIN? (IN NEW TESTAMENT TERMS)

- (1) **WHATEVER IS NOT FROM \_\_\_\_\_ IS SIN: Romans 14:23 (NKJV)** – “But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.”
- All sin is **fear-based** and **fear dependent**. All doubt and disobedience is **fear-based** and **fear dependent**.
  - **Revelation 21:8 (KJV)** – “But the **fearful**, and **unbelieving**, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.”
- (2) **SHOWING \_\_\_\_\_ OR BEING \_\_\_\_\_ OR \_\_\_\_\_ IS SIN: James 2:9 (TPT)** – “But when you show prejudice you commit sin and you violate this royal law of love!”
- (3) **ALL \_\_\_\_\_ IS SIN: 1 John 5:17 (NKJV)** – “All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.”
- (4) **VIOLATION OF \_\_\_\_\_ IS SIN: James 4:17 (NKJV)** – “Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.”
- **Facts about SIN:**
  - 1) Sin always \_\_\_\_\_ - It takes you further than you want to go, keeps you longer than you want to stay, and costs you more than you want to pay.
  - 2) Sin breaks \_\_\_\_\_. You spiritual disconnect and separate from God’s Presence, power, peace, protection and provision. (**Isaiah 59:1 - 3**)
  - 3) The wages of sin is \_\_\_\_\_. (**Romans 6:23**). Spiritual death is the 1<sup>st</sup> death experience which is **separation from God**. (See note 2 above).
  - 4) God doesn’t tempt us to \_\_\_\_\_. (**Read James 1:13 – 15**). God doesn’t **tempt** us. God calls **temptation** – **evil**. God only **tests** us to enable and empower our faith to trust Him on a higher level.
  - 5) **Two Major Types of Sin:**
    - (1) Sins of \_\_\_\_\_ - (Ex: delays in obedience; being unfaithful; lazy; etc.)
    - (2) Sins of \_\_\_\_\_ - (Ex: deliberate disobedience and rebellion and a refusal to obey; willful sin and wrongdoing; holding grudges and refusal forgive, etc.)
