SUBJECT: SUPPLICATING, INTERCEDING AND PRAYING SCRIPTURALLY - Wednesday, July 3rd, 2019

THEME SCRIPTURES:

- **Luke 11:1 (NLT)** – “Once Jesus was in a certain place praying. As he finished, one of his disciples came to him and said, **“Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.”**
 - THIS IS THE _____ TO PRAY AND LEARN HOW TO PRAY MORE EFFECTIVELY.
- **John 15:7 (TPT)** – “But if you live in life-union with Me and if My words live powerfully within you—then you can ask whatever you desire and it will be done.”
 - THESE ARE THE _____ IN WHICH TO PRAY.
- **1 John 5:14 – 15 (NKJV)** – “¹⁴ Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. ¹⁵ And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.”
 - THIS IS THE _____ and _____ of Prayer.
 - We pray according to His Word which is according to His _____. We pray and petition the answer not to pray about and talk about the problem. Answered Prayer is guaranteed!
- **Ephesians 6:18 (NLT)** – “Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere.”
 - **Ephesians 6:18 (TPT)** – “Pray passionately in the Spirit, as you constantly **intercede** with every form of prayer at all times. Pray the blessings of God upon all his believers.”

THE PRAYER OF SUPPLICATION AND INTERCESSION:

1 Timothy 2:1 – 4 (NKJV) – “Therefore I exhort first of all that **supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks** be made for all men, ² for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. ³ For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴ who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.”

- Our prayer life personally and corporately as a family/Church family should comprise of these four basic components: (1) **SUPPLICATIONS** (2) _____ = (3) _____ and (4) **GIVING OF THANKS** = a word of thanks for and about them. Opening your heart before God to give honor and value to the Lord and them motivated by your love for God and compassion and care for other people.
- These four basic components of prayer describe and outline the:
 - (1) _____ of Prayer
 - (2) The _____ of Prayer (meaning that they are not just prayed “once” but are to be prayed “on-going”, continuously, consistently and persistently).
 - (3) The _____ who we are to Pray for. (“for all men” – for others). In other words, these are “People-Centric, Others-Centered” Prayers. Prayers for other people. Putting _____ as a priority in our praying.
- **Supplications** = “specific and exact” (1) **a petition** = (an earnest request; a formal written request – e.g. boldly praying the Word, boldly and confidently declaring and decree the Word of God over others, and reminding God of His Promises, His Word on behalf of someone else) (2) **an entreaty** (e.g. a plea; an appeal; a cry for) (3) **a humble request**
 - **Ephesians 6:18 (NKJV)** – “Praying always with all prayer and **supplication** in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and **supplication** for all the saints.”
 - **Philippians 4:6 (NKJV)** – “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and **supplication**, with thanksgiving, let your **requests** be made known to God”

- **James 5:16b [AMPC]** – “...The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].”
 - Passive prayer is communion with God; supplication is intense. Until you become violent and vocal with some things, they will never be done (Ref **Matthew 11:12**). You must make up your mind that you need to have them and that it has to be that way.
 - There are privileges in _____ that many people don't understand. God tells us to “come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. (**Hebrews 4:16**)”
 - Remember God's amazing and awesome GRACE helps us in times of need, strengthen us, sanctifies us, gives of enormous and remarkable favor and blessings, empowers and enables us to practice truth and do the Word and Will of God for our lives; but God's GRACE also helps us deal with EVIL TENDENCIES in our life, our family, our Church, our community, our city, etc. **Evil** = anything or anyone that takes you away from your God-intended purpose and plan for your life.
 - **James 4:6 (AMPC)** – “But He gives us more and more grace (power of the Holy Spirit, to meet this evil tendency and all others fully). That is why He says, God sets Himself against the proud and haughty, but gives grace [continually] to the lowly (those who are humble enough to receive it).”
 - Unfortunately, too many people do not know the Will of God; therefore, when it is time to pray, they play games. God wants us to come (1) _____ and (2) **SCRIPTURALLY**.
- **Some Scriptural Supplications:** Ephesians 1:16 – 23; Ephesians 3:14 – 21; Philippians 1:9 – 11; Colossians 1:9 – 14; Colossians 4:12; for Leaders: Romans 15:30 – 32; Ephesians 6:18 – 20; Colossians 4:2 – 4; 2 Thessalonians 3:1 – 2 (NOTE: You can muzzle and mute the minister or Ministry by not (1) Supplicating for them and by not (2) Sowing into or Supporting the minister or Ministry.)
- **Supplication is always addressed to God as He is the Supreme Authority.**

- **Intercessions** = is standing in the gap between a _____ or persons, who have provoked judgment upon themselves through their wrongdoing, and the actual of that judgment. Or to put it more simply, intercession is prayer to hold back judgment. Intercession also means “seeking the presence and hearing of God on behalf of others.”
- The Holy Spirit comes along side of you and helps you to pray: **Romans 8:26 - 27 (AMPC)** – “²⁶ So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid and bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer nor how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings and groanings too deep for utterance. ²⁷ And He Who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes and pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to and in harmony with God's will.”
- (**Ref Genesis 18:16 – 33**) (This is an example of the 1st Recorded Prayer of Intercession – and it was for wicked, wretched people who didn't love, regard or serve God).

PRAYING SCRIPTURALLY TO THWART THE KINGDOM OF DARKNESS AND TERMINATE THE WORKS OF DARKNESS:

- **First and foremost, we as the Body of Christ need to realize that it's only the _____ that grows and prevails in people's lives.**
- The Word of God will _____ and _____ over any circumstance, any demon, or any force of the devil in any person's life or in any home, any community, any city or in any nation if it is _____ and _____ by the Word and the Holy Spirit.
- We can produce a CROP or SPIRITUAL HARVEST through the _____ and _____. The Bible calls people who are ready to receive the Gospel a spiritual harvest (**Matthew 9:38**).
- (1) Spiritually we _____ the ground of people's hearts through Scriptural Prayer and Sowing the incorruptible seed of God's Word (**1 Peter 1:23**). The Word has to be sown in people's hearts through the preaching of the Word, because it's the Word that brings light and illumination to men's hearts to set them free from the dominion of the devil (**Psalms 119:130**). The task of SOWING the incorruptible Word and telling people about Jesus' victory over Satan is the _____ of every believer, not just preachers. We must _____ but we also must _____ and **TEACH** the Word of God to see the spiritual harvest of souls.
- (2) Ask for RAIN: **James 5:7 (NKJV)** – “Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain.”
 - **Zechariah 10:1 (NKJV)** - “Ask the LORD for rain in the time of the latter rain. The LORD will make flashing clouds; He will give them showers of rain, grass in the field for everyone.”
 - **To prepare the ground for the seed of the Word to be planted, we can pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our communities, our city, our country and upon all nations.**
- (3) Another way to pray Scripturally to pull souls from the kingdom of darkness is to ask the Lord of the Harvest to send forth laborers into the harvest (**Matthew 9:38**). No matter how good the harvest is, if there are no laborers to REAP the harvest, the precious fruit of the earth will not be gathered in.
- Praying for revival effects change in our community, our cities and nation by pushing back the darkness.
- **Getting the Word to prevail in people's lives should be the primary goal of believers as they pray for the world!**

SCRIPTURES FOR SALVATION AND RESTORATION OF PEOPLE:

SALVATION AND NEW BIRTH SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS TO PETITION AND USE FOR THOSE LOST/UNSAVED

I am so thankful, Father, that You love my loved ones so much that You gave Your only begotten Son, Jesus, that if they believe in Him they will not perish, but will have everlasting life. **John 3:16**

For Your hand is not so short that it cannot save, and neither is Your ear so dull that it cannot hear, for whoever calls upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved. **Isaiah 59:1; Acts 2:21**

Thank you, Lord, that You are patient toward them and not willing for them to perish, but for them to come to repentance. **2 Peter 3:9**

Because it is by grace they are saved through faith; and that not of themselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

I lift them up to You now, Lord, for Your word says that You will even deliver the one for whom I intercede who is not innocent; yes, he will be delivered through the cleanness of my hands. **Job 22:30**

I claim _____ as God's purchased possession, redeemed and loosed by the blood of Christ, and I present them/him/her to You, Father God, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. **1 Peter 1:18-19**

My heart's desire and my prayer to You is for _____ their salvation. **Romans 10:1**

Therefore, in the name of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Savior, I come boldly before Your throne of grace to obtain mercy and find grace to help on behalf of these who need You. **Hebrews 4:16**

O Lord, give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit within them; remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh. **Ezekiel 11:19**

Give them a heart to know You, that You are the Lord. For then they will be Your people and You will be their God. **Jeremiah 24:7**

I pray that today they will hear Your voice and will not harden their hearts with the deceitfulness of sin, disobedience and unbelief. **Hebrews 4:7; 3:13,19**

May they plow up the hard ground of their heart with repentance so it will be softened to receive the imperishable seed—the living and abiding Word of God. For now is the time for them to seek You, Lord, that You may come and shower salvation upon them. **Hosea 10:12; 1 Peter 1:23**

Grant them repentance that leads to life and to the knowledge of the truth so they may believe the gospel, and receive forgiveness of their sins. **Acts 1:11; 2 Timothy 2:25; Mark 1:15; Luke 24:47**

I pray they will repent so they may be rescued out of the darkness and gloom of Satan's kingdom and be brought into the kingdom of your beloved Son, who bought their freedom with His blood and forgave them all their sins. **Colossians 1:13-14**

I pray they will seek You, Lord, while You may be found, that they'll call upon You while You are near, and they will forsake their wicked ways and thoughts, and turn to You. For then You will have compassion on them and will abundantly pardon them. **Isaiah 55:6-7**

Father, when they hear the good news of the gospel preached, I pray they will mix it with faith in their hearts so it will benefit them. **Hebrews 4:2**

In Jesus' name, Satan I bind your activity in the life of _____ and I command you to loose your grip and assignment in their life and on them; and I command you to cease and desist in your maneuvers against them now! I declare that Satan—the one who has blinded the minds of unbelievers—is a defeated foe, because Jesus disarmed him and took away his power, and triumphed over him at the cross. **Matthew 18:18; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Colossians 2:15**

Therefore, I ask , in the Name of Jesus, the Lord of the harvest to send workers into the harvest field of their hearts to open their blinded eyes, and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so they may receive forgiveness for their sins and be gloriously born again. **Matthew 9:38; Acts 26:18; Romans 10:9 – 10, 13**

When they hear the Gospel preached, may the veil of unbelief be lifted from their hearts, and may the light of Christ shine in their hearts so they may see and turn to Him. **2 Corinthians 3:15; 4:4**

Grant them a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Christ. I pray that the eyes of their heart may be enlightened so they may know the hope to which You have called them, the riches of Your glorious inheritance in the saints, and Your incomparably great power for us who believe. **Ephesians 1:18-19**

I pray they may be found in Christ Jesus, not having a righteousness of their own derived from the law (of religion or good works), but may they have a righteousness on the basis of faith in Christ, so they may know Him. **Philippians 3:9**

Father, I pray they will confess with their mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in their heart that You raised Him from the dead, for then they shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. **Romans 10:9-10**

May they understand that there is salvation in no one else! Under all heaven there is no other name for people to call upon to save them. Because Jesus is the only Way, the Truth, and the Life, and no one can come to You, Father, except through Him. **Acts 4:12; John 1:6**

SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS FOR BACKSLIDERS OR PRODIGALS WHO NEED TO REPENT AND BE RESTORED BACK TO GOD:

Because I believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, I can declare that I and my household are saved! **Acts 16:31**

Lord, I thank You that You will deliver the one for whom I intercede that is not innocent. Yes, _____ will be delivered through the cleanness of my hands. **Job 22:30**

Many are the plans in _____'s mind, but it is Your purpose that will stand for them. **Proverbs 19:21 AMP**

You said in **Isaiah 49:24** that even though _____ has become prey to the mighty or has been taken captive lawfully, she/he shall be delivered. For You will contend with those that contend with me, and You will save my children.

You have promised to pour Your Spirit upon my seed and Your blessings upon my offspring. **Isaiah 44:3** You will pour water upon them and floods upon the dry ground of their hearts because she/he is spiritually thirsty.

I thank You that Your covenant with them is that Your Spirit which is upon me and Your words which You have put in my mouth shall not depart from them or their mouth, or from their offspring's mouth. **Isaiah 59:21**
