When must get _____ to meet when comes. **Matthew 24:3 (NKJV)** – “Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?” Like Jesus’ disciples, we wonder what is in store for this world. ***What will happen?***

 - (3rd) The _____: Why? **Judgement of the Jews**. There will be unrestrained evil at this time. The moment after the Rapture, the Spirit of God will remove any restraining influence on earth so that things will be far, far worse than even today. The _____ year Tribulation Period will see the climax of worsening conditions, the anger of God against the wicked,
 - (4th) The _____ Coming: Why? **To Judge the World (Nations/Gentiles)** (**Matthew 25:31 – 46**)
 - (5th) The _____ Kingdom and Reign of Christ: Why? **To Rule the World** (**Revelation 20:4 – 6**)
 - (6th) The _____ Throne Judgement: Why? **To Judge the Unsaved/Lost**. This will be the 2nd Death (**Revelation 20:11 – 15**)
 - (7th) A New _____ and a New _____: Why? **To Go Into Eternity with the Lord** (**Revelation 21:1 – 8**)

What Do We Do Until Then? (1) _____ Submissively – The most important themes in the Book of Revelation is OBEDIENCE. It is because of the disobedience of mankind that God will judge. **(2) _____ Triumphantly.** This means that we grab hold of the truth of God's Word and give it back in worship to God. Revelation makes it clear that praise and worship are the vital vehicles of our response to all that God is and does. **(3) _____ Urgently.** One major purpose of Revelation is to remind sinners that eternal judgment is coming and to stimulate believers to share the Good News of the Gospel in Jesus' Name. **(4) _____ Fervently.** We must use our time wisely and well. We must work while we have time and work hard! **(5) _____ Expectantly.** The Lord's arrival is closer today than it was yesterday! We are to watch, pray, and prepare for His Coming. Be ready!
