•	PRINCIPLE #1 – GOD GIVES YOU INCREASE SO THAT YOU CAN HAVE AN
•	PRINCIPLE #2 – GOD GIVES YOU SO YOU CAN DO
	o Friends, there is never a time in anyone's walk with God that they are allowed to hit the
	brakes, coast, and stop trying to make a bigger and bigger for the Kingdom.
	 God increases you because He wants you to be capable of handling more, so you can have an
	even greater than ever before.
•	PRINCIPLE #3 – GOD GIVES YOU MORE SO YOU CAN DO MORE, NOT JUST SO YOU CAN HAVE
	MORE.
	 Let's get even ore specific. If your isn't trending up, then your isn't
	plateaued, flat lining, or just staying the same; it is trending down and you are declining in your
	GIVING.
	 When God gives you more resources, it's not so that you can the same as always and
	keep the for yourself.
•	PRINCIPLE #4 – GOD WILL DO WHAT YOU, BUT HE WON'T DO WHAT YOU In 1
	Corinthians 3:6 (NLT) - "I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made
	it grow." KJV says "God gave the increase."

THE LAW OF SOWING AND REAPING

Read Galatians 6:7 – 8 (AMPC)

•	towards the livelihood of his teacher. ⁷ Don't be under any illusion: you cannot make a fool of God! A man's harvest in life will depend entirely on what he sows."
•	The Law of Sowing and Reaping in essence sets our <u>EXPECTATION</u> and establishes our <u>ENGAGEMENT</u> to (1)!
•	Read Mark 4:13 – 20 and Read Mark 4:26 – 29
•	POINTS AND PRINCIPLES OF THE LAW OF SOWING AND REAPING:
	o Read 1 Corinthians 9:9 – 14 (NKJV) and Galatians 6:6 – 7 (AMPC)
	 PRINCIPLE #1: The Principle of = You get WHEN you sow. PRINCIPLE #2: The Principle of = You get WHAT you sow.
	o PRINCIPLE #2: The Principle of = You get WHAT you sow.
	• PRINCIPLE #3: The Principle of = You get MORE THAN what you've sown.
_	o PRINCIPLE #4: The Principle of = You get LATER THAN when you've sown. 2 Corinthians 9:6 – 8 (NKJV) a seed won't change your past. It will change your future!
II FS (a seed won't change your past. It will change your luture: PF REAPING A HARVEST
•	RULE #1 – REAPING IS NOT: Proverbs 10:15 (NKJV) – "He who gathers in summer is a
•	wise son; He who sleeps in harvest is a son who causes shame."
	Once you've sown, you have much to do in the meantime to call in the harvest.
•	RULE #2 – REAPING REQUIRES: Ecclesiastes 11:4 (NLT) – "Farmers who wait for perfect
	weather never plant. If they watch every cloud, they never harvest."
	 Are you waiting for that "perfect" moment to sow? The "perfect" conditions to reap?
	 People who continually keep their eyes fixed on negative conditions will fail to or will lose
	faith in their <u>Galatians 6:9 (MSG)</u> – "So let's not allow ourselves to get fatigued doing
	good. At the right time we will harvest a good crop if we don't give up or quit."
	 One clear sign of FAITH FATIGUE: You stop REJOICING! When you stop RECEIVING! Every time you're dealing with DOUBT, UNBELIEF and FEAR you are dealing directly
	with the Devil is a sign of UNBELIEF as well. <u>Hebrews 6:12</u> says that we inherit th
	promise through FAITH and PATIENCE!
	OUR HARVEST DOES NOT DEPEND ON THE WEATHER OUR LIFE'S
	OR THE ECONOMIC
•	RULE #3 – TITHING PROTECTS OUR: <u>Read Malachi 3:10 – 11</u>
	 What does this mean? When you tithe, the devil can't steal, devour or destroy your crop!
	o This is one of the most important rules of reaping. A good harvester is a tither because tithing is the
	key to your seed being blessed. When we tithe, not only are we honoring God with the first 10%
	percent of our income or increase, we are inviting Him into our circumstances.
