## WHY FAITH?

Romans 1:17 (NKJV) - "For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."

- Read Galatians 3:11 (NKJV); Hebrews 10:38 (NKJV) and 2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)
- Faith is not a doctrinal position or a movement. Faith is a way of life.
- 1st Big Why? FAITH IS HOW OUR FATHER
  - He doesn't function through or by fear or unbelief. We can be confident or hesitant in our trust and reliance and belief in Him and His Word - it is our choice to believe God or to believe what you see or feel.
- Hebrews 11:5 6 (NKJV) "By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

•	2nd Big Why? - FAITH IS WHATOUR FATHER GOD.		
•	God is not pleased when we are not, and He is not pleased when we are not		
•	We should allow the Word of God to reshape us so that everything we do is faith, faith and faith.		
•	Read Galatians 2:16, 20 - 21 (NKJV)		
•	If we don't live by it frustrates the grace of God. (Read Ephesians 2:8; Romans 5:1 (NKJV)		
·	Grace isthat God has given. What frustrates a Giver? Not receiving the gifts that have been given.		
•	Everything God does is by faith, and His interaction with us is by faith. When you have more faith		
	reading the Word, you get more out of it. When you speak the Word of God, with more faith, you release more power. We are to imitate our Father God, and our Father God functions and operates by  He never makes decisions from sensory perceptions. Read 2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)		
•	Living by faith doesn't involve quitting. "I'm going to LIVE faith, TALK faith and WALK faith!"  O GRACE = all that God has given; FAITH = is how we get and receive what God has given		
•	Read Romans 5:2 (NKJV) and Ephesians 3:12 (NKJV)  3rd Why? - FAITH GIVES TO WHAT GRACE HAS GIVEN.		
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WHAT	IS FAITH?		
•	Read Hebrews 11:1 (KJV) and (AMPC) When you have FAITH: you are convinced and assured of it, you are persuaded of it and you trust in it.		
When we do trust God we HONOR Him and GLORIFY Him; when we doubt God we DIS and magnify the devil and the problem.			
•	Faith is: persuasion; being persuaded; being convinced; being assured of.		
•	Read James 1:5-8 (NKJV)		
	Asking in is asking being persuaded; it is asking being sure AND assured of!		
	We've got to become: Overcoming doubt, fear and unbelief.		
	o Our is the lack of wavering. Our is a result of wavering,		
	vacillating and wobbling and not be persuaded.		
•	Hebrews 10:23 (KJV) - "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that		
	promised;)"		
COMMI	IT TO FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT OF FAITH!		
•	We are here to learn how to: walk by faith, talk by faith and respond by faith - in other words, we do things like God does it - by FAITH!		
•	<u>1 Timothy 5:12 (NKJV)</u> - "Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses."		
•	The only option tofighting the good fight of faith is to be <b>destroyed</b> and <b>defeated</b> .		
•	Living by FAITH entails and involves If you're not you may not be in FAITH.		
•	2 Timothy 4:7 (NKJV) - "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith."		
•	1 John 5:4 (KJV) – " <sup>4</sup> For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith."
