SERMON TITLE: "Christ and Christmas In Context" Read Isaiah 9:6; Matthew 1:21 and Luke 2:1 - 21 (NKJV)

- In verses, 1 3 of this passage we just read, Mary and Joseph has to travel nearly 100-miles south from their hometown of Nazareth in order to comply with the emperor's edict, a census taken for the purposes of taxation and conscription. (Conscription is the practice of ordering people by law to serve in the armed forces)
- •Centuries after King David's birth, Bethlehem ("House of Bread") would also be the birthplace of Jesus. <u>Micah</u> <u>5:2 (NKJV)</u> – "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting."
- •Significantly, this is the town where the eternal Son of God became flesh the Bread of God coming down from Heaven. When Jesus was born in Bethlehem, deity invaded humanity, eternity invaded time, and royalty invaded poverty.
- •God chose the least of all cities (Bethlehem) to host the birth of His Son, and He chose the least of society (shepherds) as the first witnesses. Shepherds were considered ceremonially unclean because they invariably had to engage in financial transactions with Gentiles; therefore, they were not allowed to worship in the temple. Neither were they allowed to testify in court, because they were considered unreliable witnesses.

- •During the Christmas season, much is said about _____. "For God so loved the world that He
- gave..." (John 3:16) is perhaps the most profound and sublime statement in all the Scripture. Jesus gave _______ and completely of Himself, and thank God that He did. We have life today— eternal life and abundant life— because of how He ______.
- •Giving from the ______ motivated by genuine love (not from compulsion, guilt, pressure, manipulation, etc.) energizes both givers and recipients, and expresses the beauty of grace.

- •The wise men were seeking the one who was "born King of the Jews." It was customary in that day that no one approach the king without offering him a gift. When the wise men were summoned by King Herod, even though he was in his royal palace, in his royal garments, there is no indication that they were impressed or offered him gifts.
- •The wise men were preoccupied with finding the One they sought. Jesus had been born in Bethlehem (literally, The House of Bread). Jesus later called Himself: The Bread of Life; The Living Bread; The Bread Which Came Down From Heaven
 - They not only offered Him gifts, but they worshipped Him as well.
- •Christ came at the right _____ and at the right _____ to the right _____. <u>Galatians 4:4 (NLT)</u> "But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law."
- •The Lord Jesus Christ is the gift that ______ ON GIVING! Jesus Christ is the ______ gift of God and gift of love! His Birth signifies ultimate ______ to all people!
- •We must _____ Christ in context at _____ by bringing Christ into our daily living: Time; Place and Conditions.
- •We are to ______ in Christ and we are to ______ like Christ! <u>Matthew 2:11 (NKJV</u>) "And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshipped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh." Have you ever stopped to think of the significance of these gifts?
- Let's examine these gifts a little closer, but I want to be careful not to over-spiritualize matters and try to make everything symbolic. On the other hand, though, it would seem that these three gifts – gold, frankincense, and myrrh – speak of three major aspects of what this child would accomplish.

- •(2) **FRANKINCENSE** was a gift suited for a ______. Under the Old Covenant, the priests would offer up frankincense... 1. Along with the sacrifices. 2. At the golden altar of incense in the Holy Place. o When Jesus rose from the dead, He began to function as our great High _____.
- •(3) **GOLD** is a gift for a ______: a precious metal suitable for royalty. The wise men were seeking the one who was "Born King of the Jews." Yet Jesus made it clear that His kingdom, "Is not of this world." **ARE YOU IN CHRIST THIS CHRISTMAS**?
- •We've been discovering and rediscovering that fact that you and I look a whole better _____ Christ than outside of Christ. You are either IN Christ or perhaps IN _____. Do you know Who you are and Who you belong to this Christmas Season? Is Jesus the real reason for you this season and every season?
