Opening Scripture Text: Read Colossians 3:1 – 2 (AMPC)

The Eight Keys are: (1) **FAITH** (2) **FASTING** (3) _ (Godly, Holy Fear) (4) _ FAMILY (6) FOOD + FITNESS (7) FINANCES and (8) FOCUS. Think of these as 8 CHANGES to a fresh start to a New Year and Decade of your life!

KEY #3: FEAR

Hebrews 11:7 (NKJV) - "7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith."

Hebrews 12:28 (NKJV) - "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear."

Ecclesiastes 5:7 (NKJV) and Ecclesiastes 12:13 (NKJV) and 1 Peter 2:17 (NKJV) and Ephesians 5:21 (NKJV) Acts 9:31 (NKJV) - "Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria and had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied."

- of the Lord: (1) positions your to receive answers; (2) promises Divine Protection; (3) provide clarity and direction and (4) produces riches, honor and life!
- What is the fear of God? It is simply defined as the reverential respect, honor, esteem and awe of God. In other words, your highly regard, value, esteem and honor God more than anyone and anything else.
 - You choose not to lie, cheat, steal, live in sin because you fear and honor God!
 - The fear of God governs and guards your decisions, your thoughts and actions.
- Proverbs 29:25 (NKJV) "The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe."
 - **Snare** = trap; noose; by implication a hook (for the nose).
 - If we fear man more than the Lord, it will us and TRAP us in troubles.
- Psalms 34:11 (NKJV) "Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord."
 - The fear of the Lord is something that is ____ and learned.
- Proverbs 1:7 (NKJV) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction." Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV) - "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." Proverbs 15:33 (NKJV) - "The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom, and before honor is humility."
