What we can learn from this parable:  1st Jesus said that is the least area of trusting God. (Verse 10)  2nd Using your faith for finances is the least use of faith, and if you haven't done that which is least, then you won't be able to do things. (Verse 11).
•	3rd God doesn't ask for tithes and offerings because He needs your money. He asks because He wants you to learn to trust Him with all of your heart; and and are the first step in that direction. (Verse 13).
