**Teaching Series:** Rediscover

**Subject:** Multi-Dimensional Ministry and MULTIPLYING as Laborers and Leaders

**Matthew 9:35 - 38 (NKJV)** – *“<sup>35</sup> Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. <sup>36</sup> But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. <sup>37</sup> Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. <sup>38</sup> Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”*

- We all have God-given personalities that affect our natural motivations and Divine enablement’s.
- Basically, we all have been uniquely shaped (**S.H.A.P.E.**) by God! We each are significant and necessary to complete the \_\_\_\_\_ (Who we are to BE) & \_\_\_\_\_ (What we are to DO) of the Church.
  - S = \_\_\_\_\_ H = **HEART PASSIONS** A = \_\_\_\_\_
  - P = **PERSONALITY** E = **EXPERIENCES**

**MULTI-DIMENSIONAL MINISTRY:**

- As this Scripture portrays, people still have \_\_\_\_\_ even after the preaching, teaching and healing was done.
- Jesus’ Words indicates that The \_\_\_\_\_ is more than a teaching and preaching center; also its more than a healing class or service. This is only the 1<sup>st</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ of Ministry.
- Jesus’ states the needs of people are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> **DIMENSION** of Ministry.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ of Ministry is the \_\_\_\_\_ of Laborers. The Laborers are pertinent to the “Harvest”.
- We cannot be a Church and Ministry @ Triumphant Word Christian Center (TWCC) where the only focus is on the pulpit. Secondly, we should not just stay in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Dimension of Pastoral and Relational.
- **Ephesians 3:16 – 19 (NKJV)** – *“<sup>16</sup> that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup> that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the **width and length and depth and height**— <sup>19</sup> to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.”*
- In these verses we see the **4 FOUR DIMENSIONS OF THE LOVE OF GOD** that are to be the internally working motive and motivation of the Local Church.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ = to be accommodating and welcoming; relevant; value Biblical diversity (different ages, stages and generations; colors, classes and cultures). Motive and motivation to welcome and accommodate different and diverse people.

- \_\_\_\_\_ = Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and the Uttermost Parts of the Earth. Motive and motivation to GO OUT and get them where they are. Outreach and Evangelism passionate and focused.
- \_\_\_\_\_ = Deep in the Word of God and in Prayer and Intercession. Motive and motivation to dig and drill DEEPER in the Word and DEEPER in Prayer.
- \_\_\_\_\_ = A fixed focus on Worship; Praise and Worship. Motive and motivation to GO HIGHER in the Presence of God.
- The fullness of the \_\_\_\_\_ **OF GOD** is comprised of the WIDTH, LENGTH, DEPTH and HEIGHT.
- Maintaining a healthy, lasting Church at TWCC is Multi-Dimensional. We need to GROW: *Warmer through Fellowship; Deeper through Discipleship; Stronger through Worship; Broader through Ministry and Larger through Evangelism*

**PEOPLE WHO ARE MULTIPLYING LABORERS AND LEADERS – WHAT DO THEY KNOW?**

**1 Corinthians 12:12 – 20 (NKJV)** – *“12 For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink [a]into one Spirit. 14 For in fact the body is not one member but many. 15 If the foot should say, “Because I am not a hand, I am not of the body,” is it therefore not of the body? 16 And if the ear should say, “Because I am not an eye, I am not of the body,” is it therefore not of the body? 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where would be the smelling? 18 But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased. 19 And if they were all one member, where would the body be? 20 But now indeed there are many members, yet one body,”*

- **#1) – THAT THEY \_\_\_\_\_ ARE NOT THE BODY OF CHRIST.**
  - We are many members (**Romans 12:4**). When the Pastors do everything – it doesn't SCALE!
  - This is not only an **ORGANIZATIONAL** but a THEOLOGICAL Problem. (**Read Ephesians 4:11 – 13**)
- **#2) – YOU NEVER \_\_\_\_\_ WHO YOU WANT TO BE.** As laborers and leaders, we reproduce who we are, not who we want to be.
  - Is what is posted on our **WALL** being modeled and practiced down our **HALLS**?
  - Am I acting as a laborer or a leader who is entitled – by wanting to be served and not to serve?
- **#3) FOR IS \_\_\_\_\_ THAN FROM.** We should endeavor to known for WHAT we are FOR!
  - Choose to be a person who wants something FROM my team and teammates.
- **#4) LOVE PEOPLE THE SAME; BUT \_\_\_\_\_ TO PEOPLE DIFFERENTLY.** Consider a tiered approach in your leadership and laborer multiplication efforts.
  - **Jesus' Model of Leadership Multiplication:** Luke 10:1 – **70 – 72 Disciples**; Matthew 10:1 – 4; Mark 3:13 – 19; Luke 6:12 – 16; John 6:67 – 71 – **12 Disciples**; Matthew 17:1; Mark 5:37; Mark 9:2; Mark 13:3; Mark 14:33 – *Peter, James and John*; Matthew 16:18; 1 Corinthians 15:5 – *Peter*
- Exodus 18:13 – 26 – Biblical Principle of Leadership under Moses' Ministry.
- **#5) \_\_\_\_\_ MAKES YOU OR BREAKS YOU!** Culture eats STRATEGY for breakfast and VISION for lunch!
