**Sermon Title:** Honor

**Opening Scripture Text:** Read Matthew 7:24 - 27 (NKJV)

In our new series, we want to by the grace and help of God is to communicate some big Biblical Truths to build your life, family and relationships on with the 8 Keys and changes we are to \_\_\_\_\_ our 2020 vision and spiritual compass to.

- Jesus Christ our Lord gave us a choice for us to \_\_\_\_\_ our spiritual house either on a \_\_\_\_\_ (Him – by hearing and doing His Teachings) or on \_\_\_\_\_ (hearing His teachings and not doing or practicing them).

- Some of these really big Biblical Truths we will cover are: (1) HONOR (2) LOVE (3) HUMILITY (4) WISDOM (5) PATIENCE and PERSEVERANCE and (6) THE MINISTRY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. Today last dive into the subject of: **HONOR**.

### RESTORING GODLY HONOR

**Read Exodus 20:1 – 17**

- Notice the 10 Commandments are about \_\_\_\_\_.
- The first Commandments are about \_\_\_\_\_ God.
- The sixth Commandment is about \_\_\_\_\_ your father and mother.
- The last four Commandments are about \_\_\_\_\_ one another.
- **Exodus 34:14 (NLT)** – “You must worship no other gods, for the LORD, whose very name is Jealous, is a God who is jealous about his relationship with you.”
- Jealousy rises up within God when what belongs to God is given to someone else.
- What is “**legitimate jealousy**”? Legitimate Jealousy equals intolerance of any rivalry!
- **Romans 13:7 (NLT)** – “Give to everyone what you owe them: Pay your taxes and government fees to those who collect them and give respect and honor to those who are in authority.”

- In today's world, we are in a \_\_\_\_\_ culture.
- **Read Malachi 1:5 - 10 (NLT)**
- Here we see an \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ SACRIFICE (OFFERING) given to the Lord.
- This was unacceptable because God laid out His \_\_\_\_\_ Standards:
- **1 Samuel 2:30 (NLT)** – “Therefore, the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I promised that your branch of the tribe of Levi would always be my priests. But I will honor those who honor me, and I will despise those who think lightly of me.” – This is God's \_\_\_\_\_ Principle.
- **Proverbs 3:9 – 10 (NLT)** – “<sup>9</sup>Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. <sup>10</sup>Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.”
  - This is God's \_\_\_\_\_ Practice pertaining to our riches and wealth.
  - **HONOR** is basically to give what's due. *Honor is about how I treat you, not how they treat you.*
- I suggest these **7 Areas of Honor** that we should gracefully and wisely engage in:
  - #1) HONOR the \_\_\_\_\_
  - #2) HONOR the \_\_\_\_\_
  - #3) HONOR our \_\_\_\_\_
  - #4) HONOR our \_\_\_\_\_
  - #5) HONOR \_\_\_\_\_ (Spiritual Leaders)
  - #6) HONOR \_\_\_\_\_
  - #7) HONOR our \_\_\_\_\_
- **Proverbs 3:35 (NLT)** – “The wise inherit honor, but fools are put to shame!”
- Let's define **HONOR** a little further. The Hebrew word for “**honor**” is *kabed*. It literally gives us a picture of heaviness or weightiness. “**To honor**” is to give great weight, importance, worth, and significance to something or someone. On the contrary, the word *dishonor* gives us a picture of something ‘light and trivial’ - one of mist or steam.
- **When you honor people, you are conveying to them that they hold a certain weight in your heart.**
- The Scriptures gives us several key truths to learn and receive when it comes to HONOR:

### BEING HONORING IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS

**Read Mark 6:1 – 6 (NLT)** *Sometimes we get in trouble because we fail to \_\_\_\_\_ the relationships that God brings into our lives.*

- We will not be able to receive the revelation and spiritual nutrition we need without \_\_\_\_\_our supernatural relationships.
- **A NOTE on picking and selecting Friends: 7 Categories of People Who Come In Your Life** – and what to do. Why? We will reap both the rewards or consequences of those closest to us and those we called friends! Our relationships will either take you closer to or further from the Will of God for our life. - **The reward of any relationship is determined by the VALUE that is placed upon it.**
- \_\_\_\_\_ is the gate through which all Godly Relationships enter. When you honor someone, you are placing value upon him or her. *Honor is making a commitment to always value and respect someone.*

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
