| • | GRACE is simply: (1) God's enveloping in and over our life (Genesis 18:3 (NKJV) – "and said, "My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant."); (2) Grace is God's very effective in our times of need (Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV) – "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."); and (3) Grace us God's empowering (2 Corinthians 12:9 (NKJV) – "And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."). Grace is God's empowering and enabling touch on your life!
