

- John 13:34 35 (NKJV) "³⁴ A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have love you, that you also love one another. ³⁵ By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
- John 15:12, 17 (NKJV) "12 This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 17 These things I command you, that you love one another."
- Romans 13:8, 10 (NKJV) "8 Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. 10 Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."
- Galatians 5:14 (NKJV) "For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: You shall love your neighbor a yourself."

	2 nd - Beginning in verse four, Paul, by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, described the of LOVE.					
-	 When he talks about LONGSUFFERING and KINDNESS, he provides us with what we need to walk through the <u>tense</u>, <u>tough</u>, <u>turbulent</u>, <u>tempting</u> and <u>troubling</u> times that we'll encounter in life. 					
	 He gives us the appropriate self-management skills for our emotions so that we can walk in love and walk in forgiveness with other people during difficult moments. 					
•	3 rd - Starting in verse five, Paul, talks about the of LOVE.					
	 He mentions rudeness, self-seeking, and other qualities. When he does this, he's describing the things that <u>love does</u> and the things that <u>love does not</u> do. He provides these descriptions to help us to picture the proper response of love. 					
•	4 th - Then, beginning in verse six, Paul, by the Holy Spirit, talks about the of LOVE, which is where he says lov does not rejoice in iniquity but rejoices in the truth, bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endure all things.					
	o In these verses, we'll learn what it looks like when we love. The Love of in our hearts – not natural human love.
