1 Corinthians 13:8a (NKJV) – “Love never fails.”

- **(AMPC)** – “Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end].”
- **(NLT)** – “...Love will last forever!”
- **(TPT)** – “Love never stops loving.”
- Last week we rediscovered the key points about the _____ of God. We learned that the _____ is different and distinct than the three other forms of natural human love. - **John 13:34 – 35 (NKJV)** – “³⁴ A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. ³⁵ By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”
- **John 15:12, 17 (NKJV)** – “¹² This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. ¹⁷ These things I command you, that you love one another.”
- **Romans 13:8, 10 (NKJV)** – “⁸ Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. ¹⁰ Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.”
- **Galatians 5:14 (NKJV)** – “For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

- We additionally discovered Love’s _____: **1 Peter 4:8 (NKJV)** – “**And above all things have fervent love for one another, for “love will cover a multitude of sins.”**”
