

## Sermon Outline Sunday, March 8th, 2020

Sermon Series: The Midas Touch: A Balanced Approach to Biblical Prosperity Sermon: "Perspectives 2.0" - (God-given Clarity of Money, Possessions and Eternity) Read 3 John 2 (NKJV); Psalm 35:27 (NKJV); Psalm 115:12 - 15 (NKJV) and John 10:10 (NLT) NOT POVERTY. AND NOT DECREASE! Our Father God wills and wants each of us as His children to prosper in all things – spiritually, mentally, physically, relationally and financially. INTO OUR LIVES. GOD'S PLAN IS TO BRING AND **FOUR (4) IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES ABOUT INCREASE** PRINCIPLE #1 – GOD GIVES YOU INCREASE SO THAT YOU CAN HAVE AN God looks at us and says, "I want to increase you so that you can make a difference for the betterment of My Kingdom." The Lord gives us \_\_\_\_\_ so that we can play an important role in His work, not our own. PRINCIPLE #2 – GOD GIVES YOU SO YOU CAN DO o God increases you because He wants you to be capable of handling more, so you can have an even greater \_\_\_\_\_ than ever before. PRINCIPLE #3 - GOD GIVES YOU MORE SO YOU CAN DO MORE, NOT JUST SO YOU CAN HAVE MORE. Let's get even more specific. If your \_\_\_\_\_ isn't trending up, then your \_isn't plateaued, flat lining, or just staying the same; it is trending down and you are declining in your GIVING. When God gives you more resources, it's not so that you can the same as always and keep the INCREASE for yourself. PRINCIPLE #4 - GOD WILL DO WHAT YOU CAN'T, BUT HE WON'T DO WHAT YOU Sometimes we want to push everything on God. But the Bible is clear on this. (1 Corinthians 3:6) GOD'S GENIUS IDEA OF GENEROSITY LIVING AND GENEROUS GIVING Proverbs 11:24 - 25 (NKJV) - "24 There is one who scatters yet increases more; and there is one who withholds more than is right, but it leads to poverty. 25 The generous soul will be made rich, and he wo waters will also be watered himself." Generosity Point #1: God didn't design \_\_\_\_\_, GIVING or SOWING for us to have less or decrease. Generosity Point #2: \_\_\_ doesn't come from money you don't have, but from money you do have you shouldn't have. Generosity Point #3: We must quit thinking about giving with only the \_\_\_\_\_ in mind but think and have the perspective of the \_\_\_\_\_ in mind. Proverbs 22:9 (NKJV) - "He who has a generous eye will be blessed for he gives of his bread to

the poor."

with blessings in return.

Generosity Point #4: When you give \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the poor you will be enriched

	<ul> <li>Some notes: (1) If your harvest doesn't come in – check your PURPOSE. (2) If</li> </ul>
	your harvest isn't big enough to meet your need – check your PREPARATION.
	<ul> <li>PURPOSE: (1) To be a blessing; (2) To give cheerfully; (3) To give correctly –</li> </ul>
	with the right heart measure and seed measure.
	<ul> <li>Sowing sparingly means to sow unwillingly – with an unwilling heart.</li> </ul>

	Provide for the Around the World: Read Romans 10:14 – 15 (NKJV)
•	3 <sup>rd</sup> Reason Why God Wants Us to Prosper – So We Have Enough Money to Pay

	<ul> <li>We need to see that Jesus just told us two things in verse 21: (1) We are to pay our</li> </ul>
	taxes, and (2) We are to tithe.

	Regularly to the Read Proverbs 19:17 (NKJV); Proverbs 22:9 (NKJV) and Proverbs
	28:27 (NKJV)
