- Galatians 5:13 14 (NKJV) "13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. 14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

	0	The entire law is fulfilled in our neighbor. The way we treat others is a clear
		reflection of our love and relationship towards God. If our love towards others is cold, then our
		relationship towards God is cold.
		 Being cold, calloused, critical and condemning to others is NOT a sign of Christian
		and religious (<i>Piety</i> = synonyms – devotion, fidelity,
		loyalty, allegiance, commitment)
	0	A Note about Loving Yourself: this involves and entails (1st) in the Love of our
		Lord (2 nd) BELIEVING and His great Love towards us (Read 1 John 4:10 –
		12) and (Read 1 John 3:23 – 24 (NKJV)) (3rd) Demonstrating our FAITH and in the
		Love God (Read 1 John 3:14 – 16 (NKJV)). (4th) in the Love God has for us – Read
		1 John 4:16 (NKJV). This does not entail being selfish, self-absorbed or self-centered.
•	<u>James</u>	2:8 (NKJV) – "If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your
	neighb	or as yourself," you do well." Loving your Neighbor is fulfilling the Law of Love.

		a concept of study and not a principle to practice.
•		s to takeaway and learn from this account:
	0	(1st) This parable and account helps bring the big question to our heart and mind - How do we see
	Ü	our neighbor? The lawyer had sufficient knowledge of the Word of God to answer Jesus' question,
		but he did not know HOW TO its truth. We know about love but do we know how to
		it appropriately? The question – <i>Who is my neighbor?</i> – gave the lawyer away
		(Leviticus 19:18). He demonstrated that his head knowledge had never penetrated his
	0	(2 nd) This parable, perhaps more than any other that Jesus told, illustrates what it means to love
	O	others; a follower of Jesus cannot separate his or her relationship with God from relationships with
		other
		(3 rd) The priest, the Levite, and the Samaritan all the man. But only one saw him
