•	What is? It is what was our Lord Jesus Christ doing when He died for us on
	the Cross, shed His Precious Blood, was raised from the dead by God our Father and carried His very own Blood into the Heavenly Holy of Holies.
•	What did Christ pay for our sins and purchase our salvation?
•	1 Peter 1:18 – 19 (NKJV) – "18 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like
	silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, <sup>19</sup> but with <b>the</b>
	precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."

•	In this first chapter of Ephesians, we see three prominent things and powerful we should embrace green and comprehend (1) We are

•	<b>REDEMPTION</b> : (Definition from Noah Webster's 1828 Dictionary):
•	is an accomplished fact in Christ. Jesus said, "You shall know the truth
	and the truth shall make you free," - John 8:32. The will not help you if you do not
	know it. Ignorance and Victory are impossible roommates.
	o You must (by revelation) what God has done for you. Jesus called the Holy Spirit
	the Spirit of Truth. God wants you to be free. He has given you His Holy Spirit to show you

		<ul> <li>3rd - The third is what you were redeemed by—Christ was made a</li> </ul>
		for you. In other words, Christ took your curse so you could go free.
	0	3 <sup>rd</sup> –: <u>Psalms 107:2 (NKJV)</u> – "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so,
		Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy; Colossians 1:13 (NKJV) - "He has
		delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of
		His love."
	0	4 <sup>th</sup> – : <u>Isaiah 51:11 (KJV)</u> – "Therefore <u>the redeemed of the LORD</u> shall
		return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head:
		they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away."; Isaiah
		53:4 - "Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows"
	0	5 <sup>th</sup> – : Read 2 Timothy 1:7 - 12 (NKJV)
	0	Let's unpack several things to consider in this passage:
	0	1st - We are not to be! SHAME is the painful emotion created by a
		consciousness of guilt or shortcoming or impropriety. Shame is fear-based and a
		byproduct of fear. There are two big types of SHAME: (1) Well-placed SHAME or (2)
		Misplaced SHAME (the kind you ought not to have).
		<ul> <li>Shame has a root and its sin! This SHAME mentioned by Paul through the Holy</li> </ul>
		Spirit is misplaced SHAME. A shame and embarrassment to speak and testify of
		the Lord.
		<ul> <li>Secondly, this text says that if you feel shame that a friend of yours is in trouble</li> </ul>
		(in this case: prison) for Jesus' sake, then your shame is misplaced.
		Mark 8:38 (NKJV) – "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this
		adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed
		when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."
	0	2 <sup>nd</sup> – We are to share in the of the Gospel. (Suffer = means to

	0	3 <sup>rd</sup> – God is able to <u>KEEP</u> what we to Him!
