Hebrews 13:20 - 21 (NKJV) - ²⁰ Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through **the blood of the everlasting covenant**, ²¹ make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

- **(AMPC)** - ²⁰ Now may the God of peace [Who is the Author and the Giver of peace], Who brought again from among the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, by **the blood [that sealed, ratified] the everlasting agreement (covenant, testament)**, ²¹ Strengthen (complete, perfect) and make you what you ought to be and equip you with everything good that you may carry out His will; [while He Himself] works in you and accomplishes that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ (the Messiah); to Whom be the glory forever and ever (to the ages of the ages). Amen (so be it)."

(which is to say, Teacher). ¹⁷ Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, **for I have not yet ascended to My Father**; but go to My brethren and say to them, '**I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.**' "
- **What was Jesus _____ to do?** To enter into Heaven as our Great High Priest and offer His Blood as the _____ once and for all for our ETERNAL _____.
- **JESUS DIED AS A _____ AND ROSE AS OUR GREAT HIGH _____ !**

- He died for our transgressions, our sin-filled offenses of God's Law and standard of righteousness, our iniquities and our wrongdoing, but He was raised for our JUSTIFICATION.
 - **Romans 4:25 (NKJV)** - "Who was delivered up because of our offenses and was raised because of our justification."
 - **Justify** = To Declare Righteous

FAITH IN THE BLOOD OF JESUS

Romans 3:24 - 26 (KJV) - "24 Being justified freely by his grace through the **redemption** that is in Christ Jesus: 25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation **through faith in His blood**, to declare his righteousness for the **remission of sins** that are past, through the forbearance of God; 26 To declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. 27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith."

- When the Apostle Paul, by the Holy Spirit, is referring to the Law of FAITH he is specifically referring to FAITH in the Blood of Jesus.

- **(1st)** - _____ through the Blood = God has set forth Jesus as a reconciliation through faith in His Blood. In our Lord's work of REDEMPTION, _____ naturally comes first.
- **(2nd)** - _____ through the Blood
- **(3rd)** - _____ through the Blood
- **(4th)** - _____ over Satan through the Blood
- **(5th)** - _____ through the Blood.
 - These are separate blessings but are all included in one sentence: _____ **by the Blood**.
 - It is of great importance also, that the believer, who has already received _____, should obtain a deeper, and more spiritual conception of its meaning, and blessedness.
- Andrew Murray said in his book "The Power of the Blood of Jesus"...***"But faith is largely dependent on knowledge. If knowledge of what the blood can accomplish is not accurate or is imperfect, faith expects little, and the more powerful effects of the blood are impossible. When we find and go through the Scriptures on the blood of Jesus in can produce greater results than what we have yet known. Faith in the blood can produce greater results. Many Christians think that if now, through faith in the blood, they have received the assurance of the pardon of their sins, they have a sufficient knowledge of it effects."*** He goes on to say...***"Our faith may be strengthened by noticing what the blood has already accomplished. Heaven and hell bear witness to that. Faith will grow by exercising confidence in the fathomless fulness of the promises of God."***

 - **(#2) - IN OUR _____ :**
 - To reconcile our relationship and favor with God and restored our fellowship with God. **Read Hebrews 10:16 - 23 (KJV)**
 - **Colossians 1:20 (NKJV)** - "And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, **having made peace through the blood of His cross**. 21 And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet **now He has reconciled**."
 - To cancel the penalty of our sins, to remove the guilt of sin and our sin consciousness.

THE ASCENSION OF CHRIST

- **Read Acts 1:1 - 11 (KJV)** -
- **Luke 24:50 - 51 (NKJV)** - "50 And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. 51 Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that He was parted from them and carried up into heaven."
- **Acts 1:9 - 11 (NKJV)** - "9 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. 10 And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, 11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."
