1 Peter 1:1 - 2 (TPT) - "From Peter, an apostle of Jesus the Anointed One, to the chosen ones who have been scattered abroad like "seed" into the nations living as refugees, to those living in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, and throughout the Roman provinces of Asia and Bithynia. 2 You are not forgotten, for you have been chosen and destined by Father God. The Holy Spirit has set you apart to be God's holy ones, obedient followers of Jesus Christ who have been gloriously sprinkled with his blood. May God's delightful grace and peace cascade over you many times over!
