Teaching Subject: "God's View of the Blood of Jesus"

1 Peter 1:1 - 2 (TPT) - "From Peter, an apostle of Jesus the Anointed One, to the chosen ones who have been scattered abroad like "seed" into the nations living as refugees, to those living in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, and throughout the Roman provinces of Asia and Bithynia. ²You are not forgotten, for you have been chosen and destined by Father God. **The Holy Spirit has set you apart to be God's holy ones, obedient followers of Jesus Christ who have been gloriously sprinkled with his blood.** May God's delightful grace and peace cascade over you many times over!

- **(Verse 2 (NLT))** - "God the Father knew you and chose you long ago, and his Spirit has made you holy. As a result, you have obeyed him and have been cleansed by the blood of Jesus Christ."

Hebrews 9:22 (NKJV) - "And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission."

Hebrews 9:11 - 14 (NKJV) - "¹¹But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. ¹²Not with the blood of goats and calves, but **with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.** ¹³For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, ¹⁴how much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

- No one has paid a higher _____ than He has. No one places a greater value on the Blood of Jesus than the Father does.
- **Hebrews 10:16 - 23 (KJV)** - "16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; 17 **And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.** 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. 19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest **by the blood of Jesus,** 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; 21 And having an high priest over the house of God; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised);"

- **Philippians 3:11 - 14 (NKJV)** - "7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. 8 Yet indeed I also count all things **loss** for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; 10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead. 12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. 13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, **forgetting those things which are behind** and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

- (1) *The DISCIPLINE of _____* - striving for the **single goal** [the **one thing**] until its completion, undeterred by obstacles or the taunts of the crowd.
- (2) *The DISCIPLE of _____* - refusing to be paralyzed or rendered complacent by the past.
 - **Forget** = to put out of mind; to count as oblivion; to lose the remembrance of; be unable to think of or recall.
 - You will never be able to go forward with God if you don't learn to _____.
 - It is so crucial and vital to _____ who you were before and outside of Christ and learn to _____ who you are _____ Christ - washed and cleansed by the Blood of Jesus.
 - **LEARN TO FORGET:** (1) The *Negative* _____ that people, pain and problems put on you; (2) The *Numerous* _____ you've experienced; (3) The *Nagging* _____ the enemy reminds you of and (4) The *Noisy* _____ of your skeptics, cynics and critics that tell you that you are a nobody and that you are never going to be anybody. - (3) *The DISCIPLINE of FOLLOWING* - intensely pursuing the calling of the Christian life until victory has been won.
