THE PRINCIPLES OF THE LAW OF FAITH

Mark 11:22 - 26 (NKJV) - "²² So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. ²³ For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. ²⁴ Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. ²⁵ "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. ²⁶ But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses."

- PRINCIPLE #1: That we all have been given the SAME ______ of the God-kind of faith!
 - **Romans 12:3 (KJV)** tell us "For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man **the measure of faith**."
- PRINCIPLE #2: We are reminded in Verse 23 and 24 of Mark 11 and we learn from these verses that *REAL _____FAITH* works by both _____ and _____ it.

 - 1st FAITH ______ WITH THE HEART: <u>Read Matthew 21:21 22 (NKJV)</u>
 - **Romans 10:10 (NKJV)** "For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."
 - Believing is the ______ of Faith; an attitude of confidence in God and in His Word.
 - 2nd SPEAKS / ______ WITH THE MOUTH:
 - Fully Persuaded **FAITH** is the FAITH that GIVES GLORY to God!

- 1) _____Others: Colossians 3:13 (NLT) "Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others."

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- (1) <u>Prayer</u>: (True love prays! True love prays and believes God for the best of the person loved without giving up): <u>Read Philippians 1:9 11; Ephesians 3:14 20</u>
- (2) <u>Provision</u>: (Chooses to freely give and freely help and support when it is available to; Truly looks to meet the needs of others by God's help and grace; Really good at "One Anothering"). <u>Read 1 John 3:17 18 (AMPC)</u>
- (3) _______to Others. (Respectfully regarding others; Reverently honoring others with true humility; Responsive to others with kindness, compassion and care) <u>1</u>
 Peter 3:8 [AMPC] "⁸ Finally, all [of you] should be of one and the same mind (united in spirit), sympathizing [with one another], loving [each other] as brethren [of one household], compassionate and courteous (tenderhearted and humble)."
- <u>Ephesians 4:32 (AMPC)</u> "Be kind and helpful to one another, tender-hearted [compassionate, understanding], forgiving one another [readily and freely], just as God in Christ also forgave you."
- (4) <u>Preference / Precedence</u>: (Others first vs Me first; From our "Me-ness" to a "We-ness"; From doing what I want, to <u>giving</u> and <u>doing</u> what others need; From being the Bragging, Big, Bad-guy to being the Godly, Giving, Good-guy): <u>Read Romans 12:9 -</u>

- 3) ______ our Marriage Relationship, our Family Life and our Church Family Life:
 - You have to <u>refuse</u> selfishness, self-centeredness, acting out of strife, bitterness, or resentment and <u>resisting</u> the temptation to harbor any ill-will, animosity, spitefulness, malice, offenses and hatred and you have to <u>choose</u> to love and <u>choose</u> to forgive.
 - <u>Romans 13:10 (AMPC)</u> "Love does no wrong to one's neighbor [it never hurts anybody]. Therefore, love meets all the requirements and is the fulfilling of the Law."
 - 3 DIMENSIONS OF NEEDS IN THE FAMILY:
 - <u>Spiritual Needs</u>: God gives and provides for our spiritual needs via our relationship with Him; His Word; His Holy Spirit; and Supernatural Relationships (Ministers, Faith Friends, Protégé's)
 - <u>Emotional Needs</u>: (Marriage, Family and Friendships)
 - <u>Physical Needs</u>: (Water, Food, Clothes, Shelter, etc.)
