<u>1 Peter 1:17 - 21 (NKJV</u>) - "¹⁷ And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear; ¹⁸ knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, ¹⁹ but with <u>the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish</u> <u>and without spot</u>. ²⁰ He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you ²¹ who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God."

- **<u>Revelation 5:6 (NKJV)</u>** "And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood <u>a Lamb as though it had been slain</u>, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth."

- For example, it was used in the slave markets to refer to the _____ paid either to purchase a person or to purchase that person's release.
- In New Testament days, when a bill was ______ or a <u>PURCHASE</u>______, the bill of sale was stamped with the Greek word (<u>teleo</u>), which means "Paid in Full".
- Even today, when we pay off a debt or a bill, we sometimes receive a <u>receipt</u> or <u>promissory</u> <u>note</u> with "**Paid in Full**" stamped on it.
- Jesus use a form of the word (<u>teleo</u>) in <u>John 19:30</u> when He said from the Cross, *"It is finished."* Meaning that the sin debt of mankind had been ______ IN FULL by His death.
- John 19:30 (NKJV) "So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit."
- Friends, when we take and receive Communion the Bible says in 1st Corinthians 11 verse 26 that we ______ the Lord's death until He comes.
 - In Jesus' death on the Cross our _____ debt was _____ in *FULL*!
 - In Jesus' death on the Cross His precious _____ was shed and redemption's _____ was paid in full!

- **<u>1 Corinthians 11:26 (NKJV)</u>** "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes."
- What does it mean for us that Jesus paid our sin debt in full?
 - For one thing, it means that no one else can lay claim to us anymore.
 - We _____ to Jesus and are forever _____ from Satan's grasp.
 - The devil can harass us and tempt us, but he can never again take ownership of our soul.
 - Jesus our Lord ______ us with His Blood and we are forever His.
 - **<u>1 Corinthians 6:20 (NKJV)</u>** "For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's."
 - **<u>1 Corinthians 7:23 (NKJV)</u>** "You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men."
