- Man is trichotomy in function, but dichotomy in substance. God created someone like himself.
- **1 Thessalonians 5:23 (NKJV)** - "Now may the God of peace Himself **sanctify** you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."
- **SANCTIFY** = to make holy, to purify, to cleanse, to set apart, and to consecrate.
 - It means to set apart something or someone for a special purpose.
