And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as *in* a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; 10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker *is* God. 11 By faith **Sarah** herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. "

	<ul> <li>We are what we want to, not <u>CALLING</u> what it is or what we see and feel.</li> </ul>
0	STEP #3: in Faith. (Vs 18 [AMPC] - "[For Abraham, human reason for] hope being
	gone, hoped in faith that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been promised.")
	<ul> <li>Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV) - "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of</li> </ul>
	things not seen." MUST BE CONNECTED TO FAITH! Things we learn about
	from God's Word: <mark>(1)</mark> Hope is the expectation of a greater future than
	current circumstances. (2) Hope is an anchor - for our souls (mind, will, and emotions); it
	keeps you steady in challenging times. <mark>(3)</mark> Hope sets the tone of our conversations. It seasons our speech. Bible is not just wishing and wanting something, but it
	is: <u>Joyful, confident, expectation</u> of good. You are <u>persuaded</u> of something that is true /
	truth; you are <u>expecting</u> something good and you are <u>excited</u> about it!
0	STEP #4: what you see, feel or is contradictory circumstances. (Vs 19 -
	"And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an
	hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb.")  In other words, Abraham considered it, then he considered it not.
0	STEP #5: To judge God and have divided loyalty against the Lord. You
	judge God as unfaithful, as unreliable and undependable to do what He said and promised He
	would do.
	<ul> <li>is big thief of God's Blessings in your life. When we God, we</li> <li>Him and Him; when we God, we</li> </ul>
	Him and magnify the devil and the problem.
0	STEP #6: (STAY STRONG) in faith by giving thanksgiving and
	praise to God. (Vs 20b).
	<ul> <li>This is how you sustained and strenghten your faith and standing in faith believing to receive. This is called the of Faith. You turn the faith <u>POWER</u> up or on</li> </ul>
	when you praise and thank God!
	<ul> <li>You keep your Shield up to resist fear, doubt and unbelief that the enemy</li> </ul>
	hurls into the battlefiled of your mind. ( <b>Ephesians 6:16 (NKJV)</b> - "Above all, taking the
	shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked
	one.")  When youris up and youris on, the enemy fiery darts won't
	to you or you.
