<u>2 Corinthians 4:13 (KJV)</u> - "We having **the same spirit of faith**, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak."

• Notice here that the Apostle Paul, didn't just say 'I have it', but 'We have it'. He quotes from David the king... **Psalms 116:10 (KJV)** – "I believed, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly affliction."

<u>Romans 1:17 (NKJV)</u> - "For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith.""

Galatians 3:11 (NKJV) - "But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for "the just shall live by faith."

Hebrews 10:38 (NKJV) - "Now the just shall live by faith; But if *anyone* draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him."
