- **1 Corinthians 4:2 (NLT)** - "Now, a person who is put in charge as **a manager must be faithful.**"
- **1 Corinthians 4:2 (TLB)** - "Now the most important thing about a servant is that **he does just what his master tells him to.**"
- People think _____ is DILIGENCE. Getting up early, staying late, working harder, longer, etc. and doing the very best you know how. This is _____ and not to be confused with or called _____. **FAITHFULNESS** is doing exactly **WHAT** the Lord to us to do and exactly the **WAY** He told us to do it. **Don't add to it or change it or come up with a better idea.**
- Faith **ACTS**, faith **FOLLOWS**, faith is when we **TRUST** God - His Word, His Will, and His Ways. **FAITHFULNESS** is when God's trusts us and we fully and completely **OBEY** Him.
- **John 14:15, 21 (AMPC)** - "¹⁵If you [really] love Me, **you will keep (obey) My commands.** ²¹The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. [I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.]"
- **John 15:10 (AMPC)** - "If **you keep My commandments [if you continue to obey My instructions]**, you will abide in My love and live on in it, just as I have obeyed My Father's commandments and live on in His love."
