<u>1 Peter 2:9 (NKJV)</u> - "But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that <u>you may proclaim the praises of Him</u> who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." <u>Hebrews 13:15 (NLT)</u> - "Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual <u>sacrifice of praise to God</u>, proclaiming

our allegiance to his name."

SCRIPTURAL CONCEPTS AND CONTEXTES OF WORSHIP

1 Chronicles 16:9 (NKJV); Psalms 28:2 (NKJV); Psalms 95:6 (KJV); Psalms 96:9 (KJV); Psalms 99:5 (KJV)

- **WORSHIP** according to Noah Webster's 1828 dictionary is defined as: (1) to respect; to honor; to treat with civil reverence (2) To honor with extravagant love and extreme submission (3) To perform acts of adoration (4) To perform religious service.
- Guidance what and who not to \_
  - **Exodus 34:4 (KJV)** "For thou shalt worship no other god: for the Lord, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God."
  - **Daniel 3:18 (NKJV)** "But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up."
  - **Luke 4:8 (NKJV)** "And Jesus answered and said to him, "Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.""

## A CRY FOR MERCY

- Read Matthew 15:21 28 (NKJV)
  - Our God is a God Who speaks things into existence by \_\_\_\_\_. He waits for us to do the same and blesses everybody on earth according to what He hears from them.
  - Today, there are things that are lacking in some people's lives because they have failed to act in
  - This woman (a Gentile woman a 'Syro-Phoenician' woman) came crying to Jesus asking for \_\_\_\_\_\_
  - Jesus wouldn't even talk to her. Why? Because her \_\_\_\_\_ was wrong. She was failing to put first things first.
  - Today that's the very reason many believers don't have their \_\_\_\_\_\_ answered either.
  - We see this woman \_\_\_\_\_\_ her approach to Jesus. What can we learn from this lady who loved the Lord but wasn't getting any recognition or results from the Lord? <u>CHANGE YOUR APPROACH</u>.
    \_\_\_\_\_ Faith to the Your Worship.
  - If you are not getting or experiencing \_\_\_\_\_\_, then you had better \_\_\_\_\_. Remember, God isn't going to \_\_\_\_\_\_. He remains the same all the time.
    - Malachi 3:6 (NKJV) ""For I am the LORD, I do not change; therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob."
    - <u>James 1:17 (NLT)</u> "Whatever is good and perfect is a gift coming down to us from God our Father, who created all the lights in the heavens.<sup>[a]</sup> He never changes or casts a shifting shadow."
    - Hebrews 13:8 (NLT) "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

- This illustration and account of this lady with a demon-possessed daughter is telling us loud and clear \_\_\_\_\_\_ your approach. Begin to \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Lord. Remember, you PRAISE God for what
  He has done, but you \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him for Who He is. *When was the last time you went before and
  just began to WORSHIP Him?*
- Our choices of different \_\_\_\_\_\_approaches:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> By FAITH we can: \_\_\_\_\_\_ the <u>subject</u> (Mark 11:23; Matthew 17:20) This is using our \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ we have been given as believers in Jesus' Name.
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> By FAITH we can: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_about the <u>situation</u> (<u>Hebrews 10:23 (KJV</u>) "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that profised.")
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> By FAITH we can: \_\_\_\_\_\_to the <u>Savior</u> for justice or mercy. (<u>Luke 18:39 (NKJV</u>)) He went from \_\_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ for mercy.
- Friends, perhaps you are not getting enough of the Promised Tithing Rights and Rewards \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ your approach. Spend time \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ God with your tithe. Tithing your tithe is an act of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. Deuteronomy 26:10 (NLT) "And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits of the land which you, O LORD, have given me.' "Then you shall set it before the LORD your God, and worship before the LORD your God.")
- Jesus our Lord is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to VICTORY, BLESSINGS and TRIUMPHS by our faith in God, faith in the Word of God and faith in the finished works of Christ. But the Holy Spirit is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to get there, \_\_\_\_\_ to approach correctly by faith. (<u>1 John 5:4 (NLT)</u> "For every child of God defeats this evil world, and we achieve this victory through our faith.").
- Now notice in verse 26 and 27, that God puts the woman through a \_\_\_\_\_. He wants to know if she is SINCERE and REALLY believes. This is where we find her \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. <u>Matthew</u> 15:26 27 (TPT) "<sup>26</sup> Jesus responded, "It's not right for a man to take bread from his children and throw it out to the dogs." <sup>27</sup> "You're right, Lord," she replied. "But even puppies get to eat the crumbs that fall from the prince's table."
- Everything was done by the Spirit of God because this mother was on her knees, worshipping Jesus and refused to quit. She refused to quit. She was determined to \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him. The Bible says withing sixty minutes that daughter was made completely whole.
- Put First Things First: We must <u>WORSHIP</u> Him! <u>PRAISE</u> and <u>WORSHIP</u> is the big gun of our <u>FAITH</u>!
- Don't <u>WORSHIP</u> Him based upon your feelings. <u>WORSHIP</u> Him because He is God. <u>WORSHIP</u> Him because He died on the cross so you could be saved. <u>WORSHIP</u> Him because He is the Lord of your life.
