•	Partnership = business partners; Responsibility = conveys the idea of taking responsibility for someone.
•	IN CONTEXT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, THIS MEANS THAT JUST AS THE HOLY SPIRIT WANTS TO BECOME
	YOUR, HE ALSO WANTS TO ASSUME GREAT RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU!

•	What are? Things are specifics of "anything", "everything" and "all things" that are not
_	necessarily spelled out or detailed in the Word of God. Any big, small, difficult, diseased,
	deformed, dysfunctional or destruction. The Holy Spirit will you and you in All
	THINGS! In Romans Chapter 8 the Holy Spirit is mentioned 22 times. Therefore, the Holy Spirit is the
	subject of this Chapter. The phrase "all things" is mentioned three times:
•	The HOLY SPIRIT Leads Us in and through All Things: Romans 8:14 (NKJV) – "For as many as are led by
	the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."
•	The word = the Greek word (ago) which means: (1) an <u>ATHLETIC</u> term references in someone
