GOD'S HONOR PRINCIPLE

1 Samuel 2:30 (NLT) - "Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, says: I promised that your branch of the tribe of Levi would always be my priests. But **I will honor those who honor me**, and **I will despise those who think lightly of me.**"

- This is God's _____ Principle. _____ is basically to give what's due. *Honor is about how I treat you, not how they treat you.*
- **HONOR** is more about my _____ than other people's _____.
- **HONOR** is more about how I see and treat you than how you see and treat me.
- **When you honor people, you are conveying and communicating to them that they hold a certain weight in your heart.** You are communicating to them that they are **valuable** to you. When you dishonor someone, you treat the relationship lightly, suggesting to them that they are neither valuable nor significant. This can be done many ways, but many times it is done through your body language, your attitude and dishonoring or disrespectful actions.
- **Dishonor** stems from one's heart, and eventually reveals itself in one's actions. Remember, man looks at the outward actions, but God is looking at your heart. Do you honor those above you from your heart, or just with your words? Do you value their presence and wisdom? Take some time to think about what you can do to show honor toward them.
- **Respect and Honor are magnetic.** It will attract people, while **Disrespect** and **Dishonor** will repel them.
- **Without respect, no employee can be promoted, and no relationship can grow**

- **1st I** = _____ - **(Read Genesis 3:1 - 8 (NKJV) and 2 Samuel 11:1 - 5 (NKJV))**
- **2nd I** = _____ - **(Proverbs 18:13 (KJV)** - "He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, It is folly and shame unto him.")
 - o **Proverbs 18:13 (EASY)** - "Listen before you answer. If you do not listen, you are a silly fool."
- **3rd I** = _____ - **(Proverbs 25:6, 7 (NLT)** - "Don't demand an audience with the king or push for a place among the great. It's better to wait for an invitation to the head table than to be sent away in public disgrace. Just because you've seen something,") **(Read 1 Samuel 13:1 - 15 (NKJV))**.
- **4th I** = _____ - **(Proverbs 26:17 (NLT)** - "Interfering in someone else's argument is as foolish as yanking a dog's ears.")
 - o **2 Thessalonians 3:11 (NLT)** - "Yet we hear that some of you are living idle lives, refusing to work and meddling in other people's business." (In Laws not respecting marital boundaries;)
- **5th I** = _____ - **2 Timothy 3:1 - 3 (God's Word)** - "You must understand this: In the last days there will be violent periods of time. People will be selfish and love money. **They will brag**, be arrogant, and **use abusive language**. **They will curse their parents**, show no gratitude, have no respect for what is holy, and lack normal affection for their families. They will refuse to make peace with anyone. **They will be slanderous**, lack self-control, be brutal, and have no love for what is good."
 - o **John 8:49 (NKJV)** - "Jesus answered, "I do not have a demon; but **I honor My Father**, and **you dishonor Me.**" (Negative LABELS, and bad LANGUAGE is insulting and disrespectful).
