TWCC SERMON CONNECTION OUTLINE:

Subject: "Understanding Our Covenant Rights - Part 2" - 10-10-2021

- <u>Emphasis</u>: The Covenant of Family Life (*Experiencing and enjoying Heaven's gloriously good plans, purpose, power, and presence in your marriage and family; Experiencing peace and household salvation in Christ at home and throughout your family!).*
- Scriptures:
 - Covenant References: <u>Psalms 89:34; Hebrews 8:6; Hebrews 13:20 21</u>
 - Covenant of Family Life References:
 - Marriage: Genesis 2:24 25; Ephesians 5:33; Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 7:1 16
 - Family: Psalms 68:6; Psalms 128:1 3; Acts 16:25 32; Ephesians 6:2 4; Proverbs 20:20 - 22
- There are typically four different RULES you can choose to live by in your FAMILY or in your Church FAMILY that either determine if you are either CHRIST-CENTERED or SELF-CENTERED.
- (#1) THE ______ RULE: "Do to others BEFORE they do to you."
- Living by this rule makes you very self-centered. You tear down and break down the Family Life.
- Genesis 31:7 (NLT) "But he has cheated me, changing my wages ten times..."
- People who live by the "Iron Rule" cheat, deprive, and defraud each of the: (1) _____, (2) _____, and (3) <u>RIGHTEOUS RESPONSIBILITIES</u> due to them they withhold and take it away from them.
- (#2) THE ______ RULE: "Do to other AS they do to you."
- Judges 15:7 (NLT) "Because you did this," Samson vowed, "I won't rest until I take my revenge on you!" This is VENGANCE (REVENGE) and JUSTICE without MERCY! This is an improper balance of JUSTICE and MERCY and an imbalance of GRACE and TRUTH. There must be a BALANCE!
- ______and ______are inseparable partners. Truth by itself kills. It is a harsh taskmaster with no loyal subjects. Grace by itself is a cheerleader without a team a spineless organism without strength or definition. Consider these tenets: (1) Relationships of truth without grace <u>dry up</u>. (2) Relationships of grace without truth <u>blow up</u>. (3) Relationships of truth and grace <u>grow up</u>.
- (1) Rules without relationship = rebellion; (2) Relationships without rules = destruction; but (3) Rules with Relationships = righteousness.
